The next census of population will take place in April 2016. In order to conduct the successful delivery and collection of census forms to every household in the country the CSO will recruit a

temporary field force of 5,180 people made up of 50 senior managers, 430 Field Supervisors, and

4,700 enumerators. The 50 senior manager positions were filled through open recruitment in June of

this year.

The CSO has now launched the second phase of the recruitment campaign with the advertisement

today Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> of 430 Census Field Supervisor positions. Applications are being taken online on the CSO web site from 9am today. The 430 positions are for a fixed purpose 6 month contract, with

supervisors working from their own homes. They jobs are spread across all areas of Ireland,

according to the population density.

The final phase of the recruitment for the census will be for the 4,700 census enumerators will be

advertised on the 5<sup>th</sup> January next year.
