
Employment Share by Sector Q1 13










Number of Persons in Employment for 3 Months or less Q1-2004 to Q1-2013








Unemployment by Duration
















Distribution of employees (%) by mean weekly earnings (€) by economic sector



Distribution of Weekly Earnings




