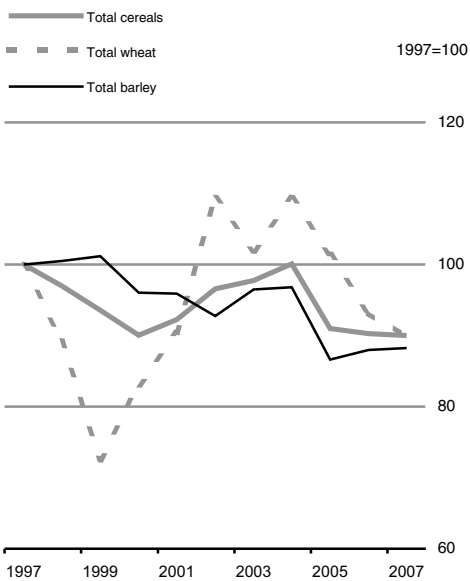

Sheep Numbers down 7.6% in June 2007

The final results from the June 2007 agricultural survey show that the total number of sheep has fallen to 5,521,600, the lowest since 1986. The decrease on June 2006 was due to reductions of 217,700 (-8.3%) in ewes 2 years and over, 32,500 (-6.7%) in ewes under 2 years, 6,000 (-6.3%) in rams and 195,300 (-7.0%) in other sheep. *See Table 2.*

Total cattle numbers in June 2007 decreased by 211,800 (-3.1%) to 6,704,100. This was partly due to a decrease of 71,800 (-7.8%) in males 1-2 years. There was also a decrease in dairy heifers of 10,900 (-4.8%). *See Table 2.*

A comparison with the June 2006 results indicates that:

- ◆ The area under cereals decreased by 0.3%, mainly due to a decrease in the area under wheat of 3,300 ha (-3.7%). However, some of the decrease was offset by an increase in the area under other cereals of 900 ha (17.9%) and in oats of 900 ha (4.4%). *See Table 1.*
- ◆ The area under pasture increased by 11.7% to 2,158,500 ha, whereas the area under silage decreased by 14.2% to 1,039,900 ha. *See Table 1.*
- ◆ Pig numbers decreased by 55,400 (-3.4%) to 1,587,800. *See Table 2.*

A regional analysis of the results indicate that the largest number of sheep (1,481,600) was in the West region, the largest number of cattle (1,320,900) was in the South-West region and the largest number of pigs (468,300) was in the Border region. *See Tables 4 & 5.*

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Diagram 1 : Numbers of total cattle and sheep in each region, June 2007

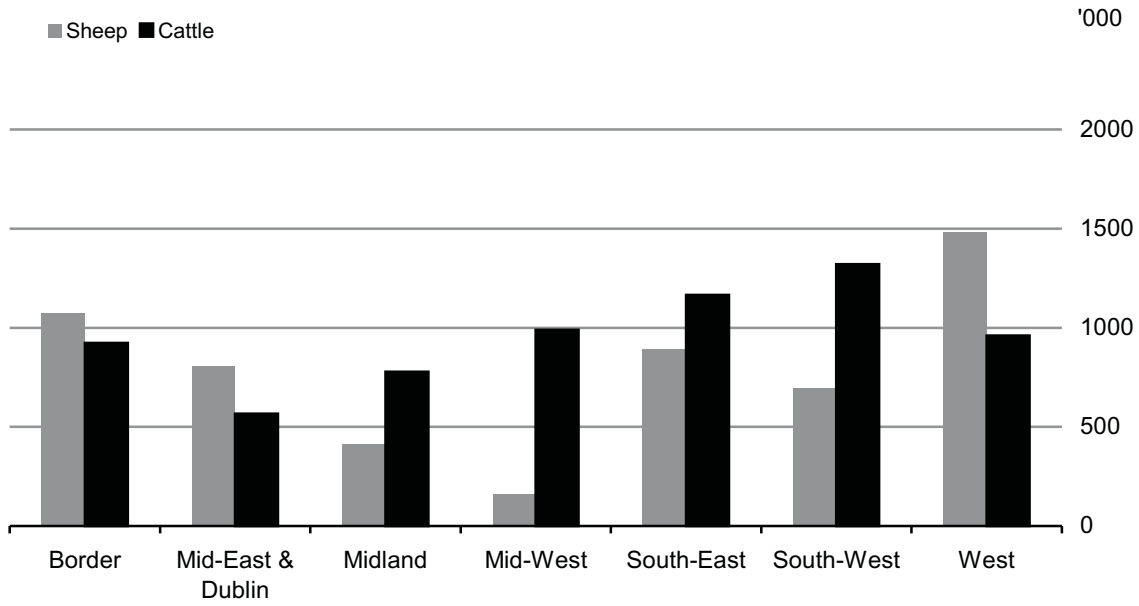


Diagram 2 : Change in areas under certain crops, June 2006 - 2007

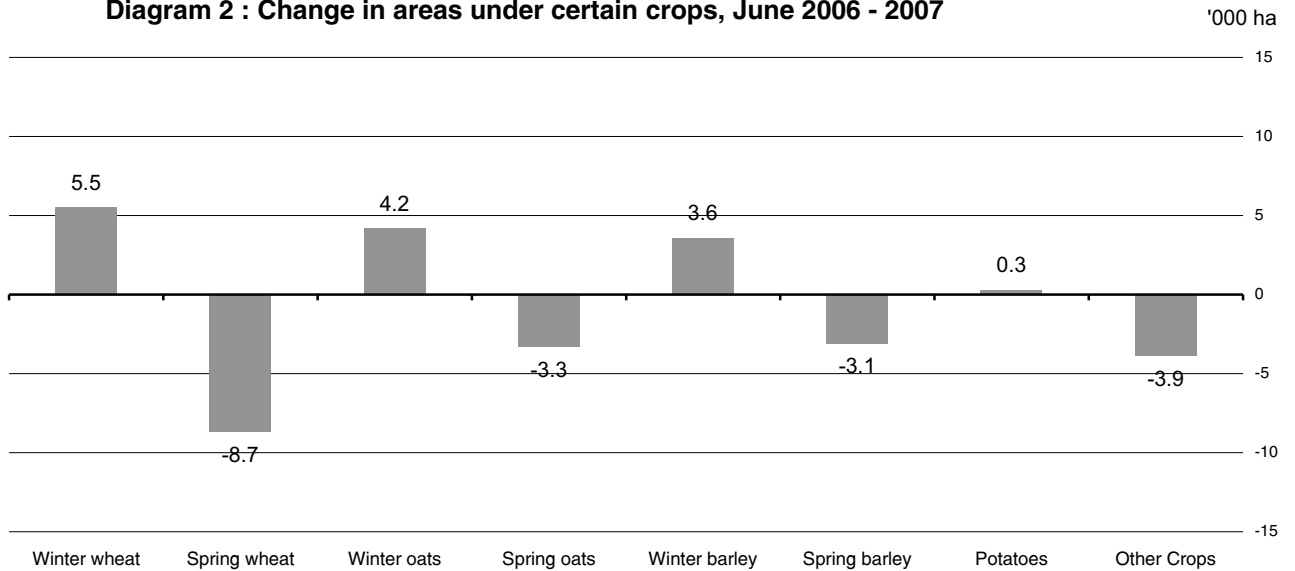

Background Notes

Introduction This release presents final estimates of land utilisation and livestock numbers in June 2007 at State level and Regional level. The estimates are based on returns from the June 2007 Crops and Livestock Survey and June 2007 Pig Survey.

Coverage Farms where the agricultural area used was at least 1 hectare (2.47 acres) may be included in the June Agricultural Survey. Farms with less than 1 hectare may also be included if they were engaged in intensive production (e.g. pigs, poultry).

Results The results are based on the trends between June 2005 and June 2007 obtained by comparing the results from the 2005 sample with the 2007 returns for the same 42,000 farms.

As the figures in the text and tables have been rounded to the nearest 100 units there may be slight discrepancies between the sum (or difference) of the constituent items and the total shown. Percentage changes have been calculated on actual figures.

In February 2006, the EU formally adopted a reform on the EU sugar regime. This resulted in the end of sugar production in Ireland and a sharp drop in the area under sugar beet. Therefore, areas under sugar beet and fodder beet will no longer be reported separately but are combined to give an overall figure for area under beet.

Comparison with DAF CMMS Data The Department of Agriculture and Food Cattle Movement Monitoring System (CMMS) has provided new administrative information on cattle numbers and on flows into/out of the cattle population since December 2002. Overall, the CMMS figure for the start of June 2006 indicated total cattle numbers some 2.7% higher than the CSO estimate for 1 June 2006.

The CSO is continuing to compare the CMMS and CSO survey figures at farm level, in order to provide a more detailed analysis and explanation of the reasons for the differences in level between the two sources of data.
