


# Planning permissions up 5.8%

A total of 9,811 planning permissions was granted in the fourth quarter of 1999, compared with 9,271 for the same period in 1998, an increase of 5.8%.

The number of new houses covered by the permissions in the fourth quarter was 9,413 while the number of new apartments was 1,073.

The third quarter figures also show that:

- ♦ The total floor area planned was 2,499 thousand square metres. Of this, 60.9% was for new dwellings (4,799 permissions), 26.9% for other new construction (1,374 permissions) and 12.2% for extensions (2,874 permissions). *See Table 1*.
- ♦ The Border region had the highest number of permissions with 1,632, followed by the South-West region with 1,605. *See Table 2*.
- ♦ The West had the highest number of new houses at 1,766, followed by the Border region with 1,614. *See Table 5*.
- ♦ The average floor area for houses was highest in the South-East region at 163.1 square metres and lowest in the Midland region at 138.4 square metres. The average floor area per unit for apartments was greatest in the Border region at 77.2 square metres, while the lowest was the Midland region at 52.7 square metres. See Table 5.

# **Background Notes**

## Scope and Background

Details of the scope and background of this series were given in the March 1973 *Statistical Bulletin*. Works undertaken by a local authority outside its functional area come within the scope of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1993 and need planning permission. Planning permission is also needed for development by the State, except where the consultation procedures provided for in the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1993 obtain (e.g. national security, public safety or order, the administration of justice etc.). This series only provides coverage where development is subject to the requirement to obtain planning permission.

#### Regions

The Local Government Act 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994, established eight new Regions. The CSO has adopted these in place of the old Planning Regions as the basis for the regional breakdown of planning permissions data.

#### Classification

Planning permissions are classified by type of development, local authority district and by regional authority. A distinction is made between residential and non-residential building and civil engineering. Permissions are further subdivided into new construction and repair, maintenance and improvements.

#### Coverage

Only final grants of permission or approvals are covered, i.e. only works which involve construction. The following permissions are excluded since they do not entail construction per se:

- Changes of a technical and business nature as distinct from a building or structural nature;
- Outline permission;
- Retention of an existing building;
- Changes to existing plan;
- Bye-law permission;
- Refusals all permissions granted on appeal by An Bord Pleanála.

## Rounding

As the figures for floor area have been rounded there may be slight discrepancies between the sum of the constituent items and the totals shown.
