# Seasonally Adjusted Live Register increases by 300

The Live Register increased by 1,465 (+0.9%) persons in the month to 173,563. This compares to an increase of 2,338 (+1.6%) for August of last year. In the year to August 2002 there was an increase of 24,124.

The underlying upward movement in the series continues with the seasonally adjusted monthly total increasing slightly from 165,000 in July to 165,300 in August, an increase of 300. See table 2a and graph opposite.

Other features include:

- ◆ The increase of 1,465 comprised increases of 765 males and 700 females. See table 1a.
- ◆ The annual increase of 24,124 comprised increases of 14,489 males and 9,635 females. *See table 1a.*
- ♦ The standardised unemployment rate in August was 4.4%. This compares with 4.2% in April 2002, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. *See table 3 and background notes*.
- ♦ In the month the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 7,930 males and 11,143 females. *See background notes*.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for March- May 2002 is 77,200 persons unemployed.

# Monthly increases in all but one region

The monthly increase of 1,465 persons on the Live Register reflected increases in all regions except the Border region where there was a slight monthly decrease of -0.1%. The largest percentage monthly increases were in the South West (+1.8%), the Mid-West (+1.2%) and the Midland region (+1.1%).

The national annual percentage increase was 16.1%.

In the year to August 2002, the Live Register increased in all regions. The largest annual percentage increases at a regional level were in Dublin (+23.7%), the Mid-East (+23.7%) and the South-West (+17.5%). See table 4.


Other regional features include:

- ♦ In August, the number of male claimants increased in all but the Border and Mid-East regions. The largest percentage increase occurred in the Midland region (+1.8%). See table 4.
- The number of female claimants increased in the month in all but the Border region. The largest percentage increase happened in the South-West (+3.0%). See table 4.

Live Register by Regional Authority




# ■ August 2001 New registrations exceed outflows:

A total of 25,540 persons joined the Live Register in August 2002. With 24,075 persons leaving the Register there is a net increase of 1,465 persons in the month. This compares with a monthly increase of 2,338 in August 2001.

Other features of the flows on and off the Register include:

- The average weekly increase of 293 in the Live Register was comprised of 153 males and 140 females. This compares to an average weekly increase of 468 for August of last year, which was comprised of 343 males and 125 females. See tables 8 and 9.
- In August 2002, there were weekly averages of 5,108 new claimants joining the Register and 4,815 persons leaving. See table 8.

# **Background Notes**

Live Register

**Source and** The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. It comprises persons under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 10)
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons (see Table 11)
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 11).

**Descriptive** The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl.7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

# statistics

**Unemployment** The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those ho work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National House**hold Survey** (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

**Standardised** The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number **unemployment** of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

> This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

**Seasonal** The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May unemployment rates, which are directly comparable with April LFS data, have been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.

time workers

Casual and part The casual and part time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.

Flow Analysis

**History of** The flow analysis of the Live Register had been published monthly as a separate release since January 1989. Similar details were previously included in the Industrial Analysis of the Live Register, which was discontinued.

Live Register Changes in the level of flows on and off the Live Register in any month reflect conditions in the Flow Analysis labour market and aspects of the social insurance system such as transfers to or from other welfare schemes, exhaustion of Unemployment Benefit (UB) entitlement without qualifying for Unemployment Assistance (UA) etc.

**New registrations** 

The aggregate of new registrations for each Friday in a given month is used in conjunction with the net change over the same period to calculate the outflow from the register. A new registration is defined as anybody on the Live Register on a particular Friday who was not on it on the previous Friday.

Area Analysis

**Live Register** The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not correspond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not necessarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.

**NUTS2** and NUTS3 regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. See overleaf.
