

Seasonally Adjusted Live Register falls by 2,400

The Live Register decreased by 12,131 (-7.0%) persons in September to 161,432. This compares to a fall of 8,889 (-5.9%) for September of last year. When seasonal factors are taken into account the seasonally adjusted total fell from 165,300 in August to 162,900 in September, a fall of 2,400. *See table 2a and graph opposite*.

In the year to September 2002 there was an increase of 20,882 (+14.9%). This compares to an annual increase of 24,124 (+16.1%) recorded in the year to August 2002.

Other features include:

- ◆ The decrease of 12,131 comprised decreases of 8,649 females and 3,482 males. *See table 1a.*
- ◆ The annual increase of 20,882 comprised increases of 13,062 males and 7,820 females. *See table 1a.*
- ♦ The standardised unemployment rate in September was 4.3%. This compares with 4.2% in April 2002, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. *See table 3 and background notes*.
- ♦ In the month the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 7,763 males and 11,271 females. *See background notes*

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for March-May 2002 is 77,200 persons unemployed.

Monthly decreases in all regions

The monthly decrease of 12,131 persons on the Live Register reflected decreases in all regions. The largest monthly decreases were in the Mid West (-8.7%) and the Mid-East (-8.5%) while the lowest decreases were in Dublin (-5.3%) and the South-East (-6.4%).

In the year to September 2002, the Live Register increased in all regions. The largest annual increases at a regional level were in Dublin (+23.8%) and the Mid-East (+22.6%) while the lowest increases were in the Border (+5.2%) and the West (+8.5%). *See table 4*.

Other area features include:

- In September the number of male and female claimants fell in all regions.
- ♦ There were monthly decreases in all counties. The largest decreases were in North Tipperary (-12.3%) and Roscommon (-11.2%) while the lowest decreases were in Wexford (-4.6%) and Dublin (-5.3%).
- ♦ In the year to September 2002 there were annual increases in all counties except Monaghan (-9.0%). The largest increases were in Meath (+35.7%) and Kildare (+24.3%) while the lowest increases were in Donegal (+0.4%) and Mayo (+2.4%). See tables 4 and 6.

Outflows exceed new registrations:

A total of 21,098 persons joined the Live Register in September 2002. With 33,229 persons leaving the Register there is a net decrease of 12,131 persons in the month. This compares with a monthly increase of 1,465 in August 2002.

Other features of the flows on and off the Register include:

- ♦ The average weekly decrease of 3,033 in the Live Register was comprised of 2,162 females and 871 males. This compares to an average weekly decrease of 2,222 for September of last year, which was comprised of 1,709 females and 514 males. See tables 8 and 9.
- ♦ In September 2002, there were weekly averages of 5,275 new claimants joining the Register and 8,307 persons leaving. *See table 8*.

Central Statistics Office Live Register Analysis

Background Notes

Live Register

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social and Family Affairs. It comprises persons under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 10)
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons (see Table 11)
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 11).

Descriptive The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

statistics

Unemployment The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National House**hold Survey** (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

Standardised The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number **unemployment** of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

> This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May unemployment rates, which are directly comparable with April LFS data, have been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.

Live Register Analysis Central Statistics Office

time workers

Casual and part The casual and part time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.

Flow Analysis

History of The flow analysis of the Live Register had been published monthly as a separate release since January 1989. Similar details were previously included in the Industrial Analysis of the Live Register, which was discontinued.

Live Register Changes in the level of flows on and off the Live Register in any month reflect conditions in the Flow Analysis labour market and aspects of the social insurance system such as transfers to or from other welfare schemes, exhaustion of Unemployment Benefit (UB) entitlement without qualifying for Unemployment Assistance (UA) etc.

New registrations

The aggregate of new registrations for each Friday in a given month is used in conjunction with the net change over the same period to calculate the outflow from the register. A new registration is defined as anybody on the Live Register on a particular Friday who was not on it on the previous Friday.

Live Register Area Analysis

The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social and Family Affairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not correspond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not necessarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.

NUTS2 and **NUTS3** regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. See below.
