## **Consumer Price Index**

#### November 1999



#### **Food**

Food prices rose by 0.4% in November bringing the annual percentage change to 3.5%, up from 2.9% in the 12 months to October. There were increases in the price of beef, bacon, fresh vegetables, biscuits and cakes, soft drinks and meals out. Decreases were recorded for potatoes, tomatoes and lamb.



#### **Drink**

Drink prices showed a marginal increase of 0.2% in November. As a result the annual increase rose to 3.8%.



#### **Tobacco**

Tobacco prices remained relatively unchanged in November leaving the annual percentage increase at 3.1%, slightly lower than last month.




## **Clothing & Footwear**

Clothing and Footwear prices rose by 0.9% in November. The annual percentage change remained fixed at -7.3%.



## Fuel & Light

Fuel and light increased by 4.9% in the year. Home heating oil decreased by 1.4% in November, reducing the annual increase marginally to 23.2%.



## Housing

There was a reduction in the cost of local authority mortgages while private rents rose. In the year to November the cost of housing declined by 14%.

#### **Durable Household Goods**

Durable Goods prices rose by 0.3% in November. Despite this rise prices remain lower than in the same period last year. There were price increase in November in furniture, soft furnishings and floor coverings.

#### **Other Goods**



Other Goods increased marginally in November rising by 0.1%. Price increases were recorded for hair applications, toilet accessories and condoms.

## **Transport**



There were marginal increases in the cost of motor oil, car repairs and maintenance, while the cost of spare parts declined. The annual percentage change in the year to November 1999 was 5.4%.

## Services & Related Expenditure



In November there were increases in the cost of education, entertainment, laundry and dry cleaning and hair dressing, while accommodation charges declined. The annual increase in the year to November was 5.8%, up from 5.3% in October.

#### **Overall CPI**



The CPI for November increased by 0.2% over the previous month, resulting in an annual increase of 2.1%. The main contributors to the monthly percentage change were increases in Food, Services & Related Expenditure, Clothing & Footwear and Alcohol, while Housing and Fuel & Light declined.
