

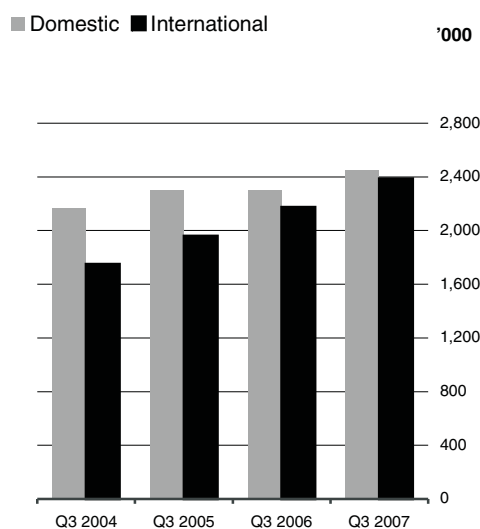

International trips up 10%

International Travel

International trips with at least one overnight increased by 10% to 2,387,000 in Q3 2007 compared to the 2,174,000 recorded in Q3 2006. Expenditure on international trips increased by 12% from €2,128.8m in Q3 2006 to €2,392.1 in Q3 2007. *See Tables 9 and 15.*

- ◆ Holiday trips accounted for 81% of total international expenditure for Q3 2007 and increased by 17% on the same period in 2006. Business travel showed a 23% decrease in expenditure in Q3 2007 when compared to Q3 2006. *See Table 15.*
- ◆ In Q3 2007, the United Kingdom and Spain accounted for 21% and 24% respectively, of all international trips, followed by France (13%) and North America (8%). In the same period, Spain accounted for 26% of the market share of all bednights, followed by France (14%), North America (12%) and the United Kingdom (10%). *See Tables 9 and 9a.*
- ◆ The number of international Holiday trips taken in Q3 2007 increased by 13% to 1,809,000 from the 1,594,000 recorded in Q3 2006. In contrast, the number of international Business trips fell by 11% to 142,000. *See Table 10.*

Domestic Travel

Domestic expenditure increased by 10% in Q3 2007 to €594.6m from the €541.7m recorded in Q3 2006. Total domestic trips increased by 6% to 2,448,000 in Q3 2007 while domestic nights grew by 7% to 11,415 on the same period of 2006. *See Tables 1 and 7.*

- ◆ Holidays accounted for 64% of total domestic trips and 76% of total nights. Expenditure on holidays accounted for 77% of total domestic expenditure in Q3 2007 and this increased by 13% from the €409.1m recorded in Q3 2006. *See Tables 2 and 7.*
- ◆ The number of trips taken in the Southern and Eastern region increased by 9% to 1,700,000 in Q3 2007 from the 1,560,000 recorded in Q3 2006 and this was matched by a corresponding increase of 14% in the number of nights. On the other hand, the Border, Midland and Western region recorded a very marginal increase in the number of trips to 748,000 while the number of nights fell by 8% to 2,990,000. *See Table 1.*
- ◆ In Q3 2007, trips booked via the Internet increased by 26% to 496,000 from the 393,000 recorded in Q3 2006 and is now the method of booking for 20% of all domestic trips taken. *See Table 4b.*

| Purpose | The purpose of the Household Travel Survey (HTS) is to measure domestic and international travel patterns involving overnight stays and associated details (expenditure, purpose of trip, type of accommodation used etc.) of Irish residents. The survey is one of several Central Statistics Office (CSO) tourism surveys conducted to comply with the requirements of Council Directive 95/57/EC of 23 November 1995 concerning the collection of statistical information in the field of tourism. |
| Data Collection | Information is collected via postal survey on a quarterly basis by the Central Statistics Office. |
| Sample Design | The HTS is a random stratified sample. Each quarter, almost 13,000 households (or approximately 1% of all private households) are randomly selected from the Electoral Register, where the selection is stratified by District Electoral Division. |

A two stage weighting process is used. Firstly, survey results are weighted to agree with household population estimates broken down by *household type* (the number of persons 18 or over) and *region* (NUTS 3). The household population estimates are provided by the Quarterly National Household Survey (QNHS). Secondly, these results are further weighted to agree with the Tourism & Travel frontier results.

Regional and Age Group Data

While the overall aggregate estimates are robust, falling response rates and reduced coverage has resulted in detailed data at NUTS3 level for Q3 2007 becoming less reliable. Accordingly, it is necessary to publish such regional data at a more aggregated NUTS2 level. Similarly the number of age groups have been reduced. We are, however, satisfied with the overall quality of detailed estimates published up to Q2 2007.

NUTS Regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS 3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS 2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS 3 regions. The composition of the regions is set out below.

Definitions

Tourism The activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year for leisure, business or other purposes. Stays in prison, military service and hospital or clinics etc. are excluded. Trips taken for the purposes of work, where clearly distinguishable from business trips, should also be excluded.

*

From Quarter 4 2005, a number of changes were made to the Household Travel Survey questionnaire. One of these changes, to the Reason for Journey question, was to explicitly include "Work" in the "Business" category.

This change was made to address the Survey's inability to distinguish between business and work trips.

The effect of this change appears to have been a reduction in the trips in the "Other" category and an increase in the "Business" category.

Also changed was the Booking Method used for trips. Two options were removed that of 'Privately organised', and 'Package Tour or Holiday'. Introduced in their place were 'Internet Booking /Reservation' and 'Other form of Direct booking/Reservation' (e.g. by phone etc.). This has allowed us to subdivide the largest booking category formerly 'Privately Booked/No Pre-Booking' into 3 categories, 'Internet', 'Direct' and 'No Pre-booking'. Before Q4 2005 these categories are grouped together.

Domestic tourism is defined as the activities of residents of the Republic of Ireland travelling to and staying in places only within the Republic of Ireland but outside their usual environment.

International tourism is defined as the activities of residents of the Republic of Ireland travelling to and staying in places outside the Republic of Ireland and outside their usual environment.

National tourism is defined as *Domestic* tourism plus *International* tourism.

Overnight Visitor

An overnight visitor is a visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place, county or country visited. A visitor is defined as any person travelling to a place other than that of usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited (i.e. work). Consequently the following are excluded:

- Short-distance local transport and commuting i.e. more or less regular trips between place of work/study and place of residence.
- Routine or regular visits e.g. visiting parents every weekend.
- For visits of more than 12 consecutive months, a traveller will be considered a resident of that place (from a statistical standpoint).
- Migratory movements for work purposes.

The following are excluded from Domestic travel:

Residents travelling within the country with the intention of changing their usual residence.
Persons who travel to work temporarily in institutions within the country.
Persons who travel regularly or frequently between neighbouring localities to work or study.
Nomads and persons without fixed residence.
Armed forces on manoeuvre.

The following are excluded from International travel:

Persons leaving the country as migrants, including dependants accompanying or joining them.
 Persons, known as border workers, residing near the border in the Republic of Ireland but working in the North of Ireland.
 Diplomats, consular officers and members of the armed forces when travelling outside of the Republic of Ireland on assignment. This includes dependants and household employees accompanying or joining them.
 Persons travelling as refugees or nomads.

Tourism Expenditure

Total consumption expenditure is any expenditure made by a visitor or on behalf of a visitor for during their trip and stay at destination.

Tourism expenditure includes purchases of consumer goods and services inherent in travel and stay, purchases of small durable goods for personal use, souvenirs and gifts for family and friends.

The following outlays or acquisitions are excluded:

- Purchases for commercial purposes, for resale, purchases made on behalf of an employer during a business trip.
- Capital type investments or transactions engaged in by visitors, such as land, housing, real estate, works of art and other important acquisitions (such as cars, caravans, boats, second houses), even though they may be used in the future for tourism travel purposes.
- Cash given to relatives or friends during the trip, which does not represent payment of tourism goods or services, as well as donations made to institutions.
