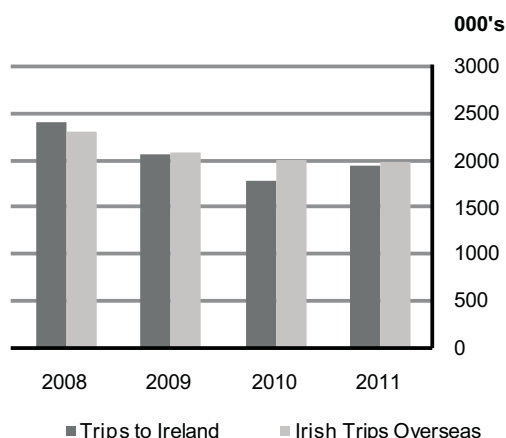

Trips to Ireland increased by over 9% for the period May - July 2011

In the period May to July of 2011, the total number of *overseas trips to Ireland* increased by 9.4% to 1,948,800, an overall increase of 167,100, compared to the same period twelve months earlier. Visitors from European Countries other than Great Britain (Other Europe) and North America both increased by 9.3% to 679,100 and 368,100 respectively. Trips by residents of Great Britain were up by 8.8% to 791,200 while trips by residents of all Other Areas rose by 14.5%. *See Tables 1 and 2.*

The total number of *overseas trips by Irish residents* decreased by 1.8% to 1,972,500 when compared to the same period in 2010. May to July of 2010 saw a drop of 3.5% from the corresponding period in 2009. *See Tables 1 and 2.*

The total number of trips (Irish trips overseas plus trips to Ireland) in the period May to July of 2011 increased by 3.5 % to 3,921,400, when compared with the same period in 2010. See Tables 1 and 2.

The CSO "Airport Pairings" database contains information on every direct flight in and out of the nine Irish airports on a monthly basis. Data is available from January 2006 to June 2011 inclusive. July passenger figures will be available from October 1st. For details please go to <http://cso.ie/shorturl.aspx/15>.

Note: This release covers the months May to July 2011. A rolling three month Overseas Travel Release will be published every month in the future.

| Periodicity | Quarterly – rolling three month release. |
| Scope | Overseas Travel. |
| Coverage | This release covers Overseas Travel into and out of the Republic of Ireland. However, travel by residents of Northern Ireland into or out of the Republic of Ireland or domestic travel within the Republic of Ireland is excluded. |
| Data Collection | <p>Data from the Country of Residence Survey (CRS) is used in this release. This survey is conducted at Dublin, Cork, Shannon, Knock, Galway and Kerry airports and Rosslare, Ringaskiddy, Dún Laoghaire and Dublin seaports. Residency data is collected from passengers by a Central Statistics Office (CSO) interviewer.</p> <p>In addition to CRS data we also include residency data from the CSO's Passenger Card Inquiry (PCI), also conducted at airports and seaports. The PCI is a survey of passengers which in addition to residency, also collects information on the reason for the journey, area of residence, length of stay, expenditure and fare costs.</p> |
| Sample Design | <p>A sample of flights and sailings is selected to facilitate proper representation of airport/seaport pairings, day, night, week day and weekend flights/sailings.</p> <p>On the selected flights/sailings for the CRS, a 1 in 5 (20%) systematic sample of passengers is selected and their country of residence is recorded. In the PCI survey a sample of flights/sailings are selected and a PCI card is distributed to all passengers on these flights/sailings.</p> <p>Sample results are grossed to total passenger numbers travelling for each airport or seaport pairing, as provided by the airports and ferry companies.</p> <p>Where there is no survey coverage in a period for an airport/seaport pairing, results are imputed using the 'nearest neighbour' imputation methodology.</p> |
| Sample Size | The sample size for the Overseas Travel release in respect of the three month period May - July 2011 was just under 192,700 passengers. |
| Reliability of Results | <p>Estimation of survey results using the above sampling design introduces a statistical variability which would not be present if <i>all</i> passengers from <i>every</i> flight/sailing had been sampled. This means that the survey results are best estimates based on the information collected for the sample.</p> <p>This variability is expressed by the standard error calculation. The standard error gives the relative size of the 'sampling error' (variability) present in an estimate compared with the estimate itself. In general, estimates can be said to have a relative precision of twice their standard error.</p> <p>The effect of sampling error is greater for small estimates and may, in particular, make it more difficult to compare figures for different time periods. Standard error estimates in respect of the major Area of Residence categories for Quarter 1 and Quarter 2 2011 calendar quarters are presented in the following tables.</p> |

In general, the more detailed the classification provided the greater the standard error of the estimates. In the derivation of the results, the assumption was made that non-respondents had similar characteristics and activity levels to those respondents in the same stratification cell. This assumption, which is usual in surveys such as this, may introduce some slight bias into the results. Moreover, although every effort was made to ensure that the information collected is correct, it is possible that some minor non-sampling errors remain undetected.

Definitions

- (1) Trips** The data presented in this report is in terms of trip numbers. A trip is defined as a journey (usually including the return) from one place to another.
- (2) Visitor** The definition of Visitor used in these surveys is based on that agreed with Eurostat, the European Statistical Office. A Visitor is defined as '*any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited*'. However, as the CRS does not establish the reason for an individual's trip or length of stay, those travelling for reason of remuneration or for more than one year to a country cannot be excluded. Therefore, trips may include those travelling for paid work. Commercial Drivers travelling on sea routes are excluded.
- (3) Country of Residence** Country of Residence is defined as the country in which the person has resided during the past year.
- Easter** Easter falls each year on a Sunday between March 22nd and April 25th, inclusively. In 2011 Easter Sunday fell on April 24th, while in 2010 it fell on April 4th. Visitor numbers each year are greatly influenced by when Easter falls.
