# Average age of bride and groom continues to rise

The number of marriages registered in 2007 was 22,756, which equates to a crude marriage rate of 5.2 per 1,000 of the population. This compares with a total of 22,089 and a similar marriage rate of 5.2 per thousand in 2006. *See table 1*.

The average age of grooms in 2007 was 33.4 years, slightly higher than 33.2 years in 2006 but an increase of 3.2 on the 1996 figure. The pattern for brides is similar with the average age increasing from 28.4 years in 1996 to 31.2 and 31.3 years in 2006 and 2007 respectively. *See table 1*.

The number of Roman Catholic marriage ceremonies was 16,854 in 2007 and accounted for 74% of all marriages in the year. Roman Catholic marriages accounted for 73% of all marriages in 2006 and 90% of all marriages in 1996. The number of civil marriages was 5,146 or just under 23% of all marriages in 2007, a slight increase of 19 on the 2006 figure. In 1996, there were 928 civil marriages (6%) in Ireland, when divorce was not yet legalised. *See table 1 and fig 2*.

Marriages where both the bride and groom were residing in Ireland before marriage accounted for 92% (20,926) of marriages. Of these, 84% were residing in the same local authority area before marriage. *See tables 11 and 12*.

The Marriages figures in this release also show that:

- ◆ The most popular month for marriage in 2007 was August, when 15% of marriages occurred. Marriages in June, July, August and September accounted for 54% of all marriages in the year. January was the least popular month with just 3% of marriages occurring during that month. See table 16 and fig 6.
- ♦ Friday and Saturday were the most popular days of the week to get married in 2007, accounting for 72% of all marriages. The least popular day was Sunday when just over 1% of marriages were recorded. See table 16 and fig 5.

Fig. 2 Marriages by form of ceremony, 2007




Fig. 3 Groom by relative age of bride





Fig. 4 Bride by relative age of groom



# Marriages by form of ceremony

There were 22,756 marriages registered in 2007. Of these, 16,854 were Roman Catholic marriage ceremonies (74%), 5,146 civil marriages (23%), 526 Church of Ireland ceremonies (2%) and the remaining 1% made up of Presbyterian, Methodist, Jewish and other ceremonies. *See table 1 and fig 2*.

In 1996, civil marriages accounted for 6% of all marriages and increased to 18% in 2002. A contributing factor to the increases was the legislation of divorce in 1997. In more recent years, the number of civil partnerships has remained somewhat more constant at 22%, 23% and 23% of marriages in 2005, 2006 and 2007 respectively. Of the 5,146 civil marriages in 2007, 1,872 (36%) involved at least one divorced person. *See tables 1 and 17*.

The average age of the groom in 2007, in Roman Catholic marriages, was 32.3 years and the average age of the groom in civil marriages was 36.8 years. The average age of the bride in Roman Catholic marriages was 30.5 years and the average age of the bride in civil marriages was 33.9 years. *See table 3*.

In 2007, civil marriage ceremonies were the most common form of ceremony for grooms aged 45 and over and for brides aged 40 and over. In marriage ceremonies, where the bride was aged 40 or over, civil marriages accounted for 65% of ceremonies, while the comparable figure for grooms in the same age category was just over 54%. *See table 3*.

At a NUTS3 regional level, over 30% of grooms and brides in the Dublin region had civil marriages. By contrast, 17% of grooms in the Midlands and Western regions and over 16% of brides living in the Western region, had civil marriages. *See tables 14 and 15*.

Just over 40% of grooms residing in Galway City had civil marriages. On the other hand, 10.5% of brides living in County Donegal had civil marriages. *See tables 14 and 15*.

## Marriages by age of bride and groom

The average age of grooms in 2007 was 33.4 years, while the average age of brides was 31.3 years in 2007. The average age of grooms marrying for the first time was 32.3 years. The average age among widowers was 55.6 years, and the average age among divorced men was 46.8 years. Women marrying for the first time had an average age of 30.5 years, widows 51.6 years, and divorced women 42.7 years. *See tables 22 and 23*.

In 2007, the groom was older than the bride in 63% of marriages, the same age in a further 12% of marriages and in the remaining 24% of cases the bride was older than the groom. This was generally witnessed across all age groups except in the case of males under 25, where the bride was older in 49% of marriages, the same in 16% and younger in 35% of marriages. See tables 7, 8 and figs 3 and 4.

In 2007, over 66% of grooms were aged thirty or over on their wedding day which compares with a little over 65% and 42% in 2006 and 1996 respectively. The proportion of older brides has also increased, with over 52% aged thirty or over in 2007 compared with just over 51% in 2006 and almost 28% in 1996. *See table 1*.

At a provincial level, Ulster had the lowest average age for grooms and brides at 31.8 years and 29.5 years respectively, while at a county level, the highest average age for grooms was in Dun Laoghaire Rathdown, with an average age of 35.2 years, with the lowest average age of 32.0 years in County Monaghan. Similarly, for brides the highest average age was in Dun Laoghaire Rathdown, 32.9 years, with Monaghan having the lowest average age of 29.3 years. *See tables 9 and 10.* 

Fig. 5 Marriages by day of week, 2007





Fig. 6 Marriages by month, 2007



# Marriages by marital status

There were 21,095 (92.7%) grooms and 21,319 (93.7%) brides marrying for the first time in 2007. There were 175 (0.8%) widowers and 154 (0.7%) widows who married in 2007. Divorced men accounted for 6.5% (1,486) of grooms while divorced women accounted for 5.6% (1,283) of brides. *See tables 22 & 23*.

There were 2,320 marriages involving at least one divorced person in 2007, including 449 marriages where both parties were divorced. Civil ceremonies accounted for 1,872 of these marriages, 330 were Roman Catholic ceremonies, and 118 were other religious ceremonies. *See table 17*.

Over 8.4% of grooms in the South-East region were divorced men, the highest proportion in the country. In contrast, only 4.9% of grooms in the Midland region were divorced. For brides the highest proportion of divorcees was in the Mid-East region (7.0%) while the lowest proportion was in the West (4.3%). *See tables 18 and 19*.

### Marriages by residence of bride and groom

Marriages where both the bride and groom were residing in Ireland before marriage accounted for 92% (20,926) of marriages. Of these, 84% were residing in the same local authority area before marriage, 90% within the same regional authority and 94% within the same province. *See tables 11 and 12*.

Almost 91% of grooms residing in Louth married brides residing in Louth. On the other hand, only 64% of Roscommon grooms married brides residing in Roscommon. In relation to brides, 89% of brides residing in Wicklow married grooms residing in Wicklow, while at the other end of the scale just under 64% of Roscommon brides married grooms residing in Roscommon. See tables 11 and 12.

In 1996, 1,813 (11%) marriages involved both the bride and groom living outside the State before marriage. In 2007, this was the case for 1,352 (6%) marriages. In a further 381 cases a non-resident groom married a bride resident in the State while just 97 non resident brides married grooms living here. *See tables 11 and 12*.

The future permanent residence of married couples was stated to be outside Ireland in 7.9% (1,798) of marriages, compared with 16.1% (2,604) in 1996. *See table 1.* 

### Marriages by socio-economic group

Almost 19% (4,277) of all marriages involved the bride and groom being of the same socio-economic group.

Almost 27% of grooms and just over 27% of brides in the 'higher professional' category married persons in the same socio-economic group. Similarly, almost 25% of grooms and 26% of brides in the 'employer and managers' socio-economic group married a spouse in the same group and 21.5% of grooms and 21.4% of brides in the 'other non-manual' married within their own group. See table 6 and background notes page 27.

For those in the 'lower professional' group, 42.7% of grooms and 16.9% of brides married within the group and in the 'intermediate non-manual workers' group, 32.7% of grooms and 11.0% of brides married spouses from the same socio-economic group. See table 6 and background notes page 27.

# **Background Notes**

#### Source

These statistics have been compiled from the marriage registration forms of all marriages registered in the Republic of Ireland in 2007.

The release has been prepared by the Central Statistics Office for the Minister for Health and Children in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of the Vital Statistics and Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act, 1952 and Section 73 of the Civil Registration Act, 2004.

### Methodology

Where the weekday and month of a marriage are specified in this release, it refers to the date on which the marriage occurred. Note that some marriages registered in 2007 (and hence included in these statistics) occurred in years before 2007.

### **Form of Ceremony**

Marriages celebrated according to the rites and ceremonies of the Roman Catholic Church, the rites and ceremonies of the Church of Ireland, the forms and disciplines of the Presbyterian Church, the usages of the Society of Friends, the usages of people professing the Jewish religion, and the usages of certain other Religious Bodies have been classified under their respective religions.

There is at present no provision for the civil registration of Muslim Marriage Ceremonies solemnised in the State.

### Socio-Economic Group (SEG)

This classification is determined by a person's occupation or, in some cases by a combination of occupation and employment status. The men and women whose marriages were registered in 2007 were classified by SEG on the basis of the information on occupation given in the marriage register.

Area of residence

Four classifications of district are available: that in which the marriage took place, the areas of residence of the bride and groom prior to marriage, and the intended future residence.

Age specific marriage rates

The age specific marriage rates are calculated as follows:

Age Specific Rate = Number of Males(or Females) of that age whose marriages were registered multiplied by 1,000 and divided by Population of Males (or Females) of that age. The small number of marriages for which the age is not stated are distributed in proportion

before this calculation is made.

Marriages per 1,000 population

This is calculated for each year as follows:

Marriages per 1,000 population = Number of Marriages registered multiplied by 1,000 and

divided by population. 2007 population is 4,339.0 thousands.
