CHANGES, 1971-1981, IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE AREAS DISTINGUISHED IN THE CENSUS

CHANGES IN BOUNDARIES OF COUNTIES

Under the Local Government Provisional Order Confirmation Act, 1976 (No. 1 (Private) of 1976), part of the D.E.D. of St. Mary's in Meath County was detached from that county and added to Louth County. Comparative population figures from 1961 shown in this Volume for the two counties in question relate to the areas of those counties as constituted after the coming into operation of the abovementioned Act.

CHANGES IN LEGALLY DEFINED BOUNDARIES OF TOWNS

Since 1971, the following changes in boundaries have been made in respect of the towns specified in this Appendix. In each case, the comparative population figures for 1971 shown in this Volume relate to the area of the town as constituted after the coming into operation of the Order in question.

BRAY

Under the Urban District of Bray (Alteration of Boundary) Order, 1978 (S.I. No. 370 of 1978) part of the D.E.D. of Kilmacanogue was transferred to the Urban District of Bray.

DROGHEDA

Under the Local Government Provisional Order Confirmation Act, 1976 (No. 1 (Private) of 1976), part of the D.E.D's of St. Peter's (County Louth) and St. Mary's (County Meath) were transferred to the Municipal Borough of Drogheda.

NAVAN

Under the Urban District of Navan (Alteration of Boundary) Order, 1975 (S.I. No. 162 of 1975) part of the D.E.D. of Navan Rural was transferred to the Urban District of Navan.

TRALEE

Under the Urban District of Tralee (Alteration of Boundary) Order, 1973 (S.I. No. 222 of 1973) and the Urban District of Tralee (Alteration of Boundary) Order, 1979 (S.I. No. 408 of 1979) parts of the D.E.D. of Tralee Rural were transferred to the Urban District of Tralee.

WATERFORD COUNTY BOROUGH

Under the Local Government Provisional Order Confirmation Act, 1979 (No. 2 (Private) of 1979) parts of the D.E.D's of Ballinakill, Faithlegg and Kilbarry and the remainder of the D.E.D. of Waterford Rural were added to the County Borough of Waterford.

YOUGHAL

Under the Urban District of Youghal (Alteration of Boundary) Order, 1978 (S.I. No. 102 of 1978) part of the D.E.D. of Youghal Rural was transferred to the Urban District of Youghal.

REVISION OF DAIL CONSTITUENCIES

The Constituencies were revised in 1980 under the terms of the Electoral (Amendment) Act, 1980. The population totals for these Constituencies are shown in Table 15.

CHANGES IN BOUNDARIES OF ELECTORAL AREAS

Since 1971 the following changes in Electoral Areas have taken place:-

CARLOW COUNTY

Under the Carlow County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 46 of 1974) the County of Carlow was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 11.

Under the Clare County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 48 of 1974) the County of Clare was divided into five Electoral Areas as shown in Table 11.

CORK COUNTY BOROUGH

Under the Cork County Borough (Electoral Areas) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 27 of 1974) the County Borough of Cork was divided into six Electoral Areas as shown in Table 11.

DONEGAL COUNTY

Under the Donegal County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 51 of 1974) the County of Donegal was divided into five Electoral Areas as shown in Table 11.

DUBLIN COUNTY BOROUGH

Under the Dublin County Borough (Electoral Areas) Order, 1979 (S.I. No. 41 of 1979) the County Borough of Dublin was divided into eleven Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

DUBLIN COUNTY

Under the Dublin County Council Order, 1979 (S.I. No. 40 of 1979) the County of Dublin was divided into nine Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

GALWAY COUNTY

Under the Galway County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 47 of 1974) the County of Galway was divided into five Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

KERRY COUNTY

Under the Kerry County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 30 of 1974) the County of Kerry was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

KILDARE COUNTY

Under the Kildare County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 49 of 1974) the County of Kildare was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

Under the Sligo County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 23 of 1974) the County of Sligo was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

WESTMEATH COUNTY

Under the Westmeath County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 34 of 1974) the County of Westmeath was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

LEITRIM COUNTY

Under the Leitrim County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 21 of 1974) the County of Leitrim was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

LIMERICK COUNTY

Under the Limerick County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 31 of 1974) the County of Limerick was divided into five Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

LONGFORD COUNTY

Under the Longford County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 22 of 1974) and the Longford County Council (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 50 of 1974) the County of Longford was divided into five Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

LOUTH COUNTY*

Under the Louth County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 32 of 1974) the County of Louth was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

MEATH COUNTY*

Under the Meath County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 33 of 1974) the County of Meath was divided into five Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

ROSCOMMON COUNTY

Under the Roscommon County Council (Amendment) Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 11 of 1974) the County of Roscommon was divided into four Electoral Areas as shown in Table 16.

WATERFORD COUNTY AND COUNTY BOROUGH

Under the Local Government Provisional Order Confirmation Act, 1979 (No. 2 (Private) of 1979) the areas added to Waterford County Borough from Waterford County were transferred to Waterford Borough Electoral Areas Nos. 1, 2 and 3 from the County Electoral Area of Tramore.

EXTENSION OF THE GAELTACHT AREAS

Under the Gaeltacht Areas Order, 1974 (S.I. No. 192 of 1974) the District Electoral Divisions of Ballyduff, Brandon, Cloghane and part of the District Electoral Division of Stradbally in County Kerry, together with parts of the District Electoral Divisions of Ardmore, Ballymacart and Ringville in County Waterford were added to the Gaeltacht.

^{*}Under the Local Government Provisional Order Confirmation Act, 1976 (No. 1 (Private) of 1976) the area added to Louth County from Meath County was transferred to the County Electoral Area of Drogheda from the County Electoral Area of Slane.

APPENDIX B

DEFINITION OF SUBURBS

District Electoral Divisions (D.E.D.s) outside legally defined cities and towns normally comprise groups of complete townlands. The revision of the boundaries of D.E.D.s in Dublin County in 1971 resulted in the division of a considerable number of townlands between two or more D.E.D.s. Most of these townlands are in the suburban areas adjoining Dublin County Borough and Dun Laoghaire Borough. For the purpose of the definitions given hereunder for the Greater Dublin Suburbs all that part of one of the townlands in question within a D.E.D. is treated as if it were a complete and separate townland.

GREATER DUBLIN - NORTH SUBURBS

Greater Dublin - North Suburbs comprise the complete D.E.D. of Castleknock; the townlands of Abbotstown, Blanchardstown, Cappoge, Corduff, Dunsink, Huntstown (pt.) and Scribblestown in the D.E.D. of Blanchardstown; the townlands of Blakestown, Clonsilla, Coolmine, Hartstown (pt.), Kellystown (pt.) and Sheepmoor in the D.E.D. of Clonsilla; the townlands of Balgriffin (pt.), Belcamp (pt.), Darndale, Fairfield, Grange (pt.), Kilmore Big, Newbrook, Newtown, Priorswood, Santry, Shrubs, Tonlegee and Willsborough in the D.E.D. of Coolock; the townlands of Balbutcher, Balcurris, Clonmel and Stormanstown in the D.E.D. of Drumcondra Rural No. 1; the townlands of Santry, Stormanstown and Turnapin Little in the D.E.D. of Drumcondra Rural No. 2; and the townlands of Jamestown Great (pt.) and Kildonan (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Finglas.

GREATER DUBLIN - SOUTH SUBURBS

Greater Dublin - South Suburbs comprise the complete D.E.Ds. of Ballybrack No. 1, Clondalkin No. 1, Dundrum No. 1, Dundrum No. 2, Dundrum No. 3, Dundrum No. 4, Dundrum No. 5, Milltown No. 1, Milltown No. 2, Palmerston No. 1, Palmerston No. 2, Rathfarnham No. 1, Rathfarnham No. 2, Stillorgan No. 1, Stillorgan No. 2, Stillorgan No. 3, Stillorgan No. 4, Stillorgan No. 5, Tallaght No. 1, Tallaght No. 2, Terenure No. 1, Terenure No. 2, Terenure No. 3, Terenure No. 4; the townlands of Brennanstown, Carrickmines Great (pt.), Cherrywood (pt.), Laughanstown (pt.) and Loughlinstown in the D.E.D. of Ballybrack No. 2; the townlands of Bawnoges, Bedlesshill (pt.), Brideswell Commons, Buck and Hounds (pt.), Clonburris Great, Clondalkin, Commons, Deansrath, Fairview, Kilmahuddrick and Newlands Demesne in the D.E.D. of Clondalkin No. 2; the townlands of Balally (pt.), Ballyedmonduff (pt.), Ballyogan, Barnacullia (pt.), Carmanhall and Leopardstown, Carrickmines Little, Foxrock, Galloping Green, Glebe, Glenamuck North, Glenamuck South, Jamestown, Kilgobbin, Kiltiernan (pt.), Kiltiernan Domain (pt.), Kingstown, Murphystown, Newtown Little, Tipperstown and Woodside in the D.E.D. of Glencullen; the townlands of Ballymanaggin and Cappagh in the D.E.D. of Lucan No. 1; the townlands of Belgard, Cookstown, Jobstown, Oldbawn (pt.), Tallaght, Whitehall and Whitestown in the D.E.D. of Tallaght No. 3; the townlands of Ballyboden, Edmondstown, Harold's Grange, Knocklyon, Newtown (pt.), Scholarstown, Taylor's Grange (pt.) and Whitechurch in the D.E.D. of Whitechurch.

CORK SUBURBS

Cork Suburbs comprise the townlands of Ardarrig, Ballybrack, Castletreasure (pt.), Douglas, Grange, Hop Island, Maryborough, Moneygurney (pt.), Monfieldstown, Mounthovel and Rochestown (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Douglas; the townlands of Ardarostig (pt.), Chetwynd (pt.), Doughcloyne (pt.) and Garranedarragh (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Inishkenny; the townlands of Ballycurreen (pt.), Curraghconway (pt.), Grange (pt.), Inchisarsfield, Lehenagh Beg (pt.) and Lehenagh More (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Rathcooney and the townlands of Ballincolly (pt.), Ballysheehy (pt.), Ballyvolane (Rural) (pt.), Clogheen (pt.), Commons (Rural) (pt.), Coolymurraghue (pt.), Garranabraher (Rural) (pt.), Knocknacullen East (pt.) and Mount Desert in the D.E.D. of St. Mary's.

LIMERICK SUBURBS

Limerick Suburbs comprise the townlands of Ballycummin (pt.), Ballykeefe (pt.), Dooradoyle (pt.), Gouldavoher (pt.) and Sluggary (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Ballycummin; the townlands of Ballysimon (pt.), Dromroe, Kilbane, Killonan (pt.), Milltown (pt.), Newcastle (pt.), Newtown (pt.), Peafield and Sreelane in the D.E.D. of Ballysimon; the townlands of Ballysimon (pt.), Caherdavin, Clonconane (pt.), Clonmacken, Knock and Shanabooly in the D.E.D. of Limerick North Rural; the townlands of Ballysheedy East (pt.), Rathbane South, Rathurd (pt.), Reboge (Rural), Reboge Meadows, Rossbrien (pt.) and Singland (Rural) in the D.E.D. of Limerick South Rural and, in Clare County, the townlands of Athlunkard, Ballykeelaun (pt.), Cloonoughter (pt.), Fairyhill, Garraun, Gortatogher, Kilquane, Knockballynameath, Parteen (pt.), Rosmadda East (pt.), Rosmadda West (pt.) and Shanakyle (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Ballyglass.

WATERFORD SUBURBS

Waterford Suburbs comprise the townlands of Abbeylands (Rural) (pt.), Belmount (pt.), Christendom, Mountmisery, Mountsion, Newrath (pt.), Newtown, Rathculliheen (pt.) and Rockshire (Rural) (pt.) in the D.E.D. of Kilculliheen in KILKENNY COUNTY.
