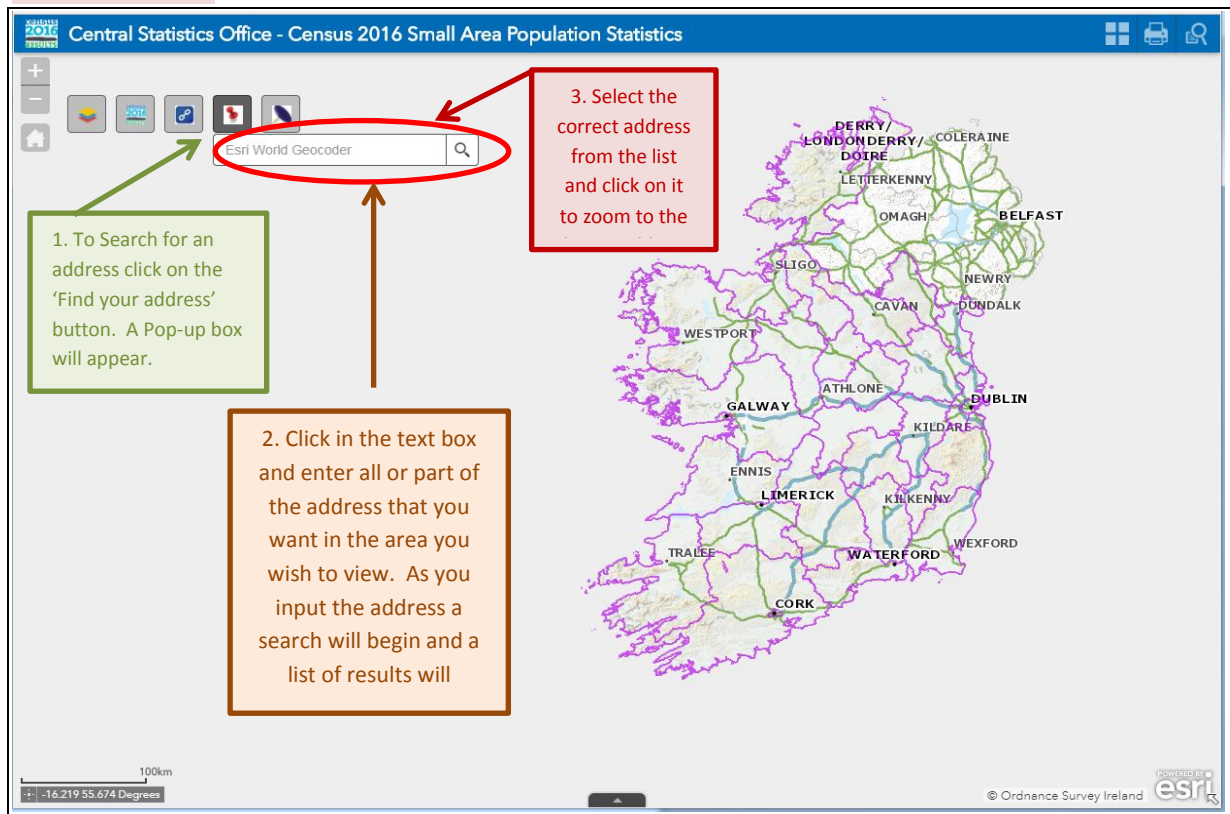
SapMap Functions

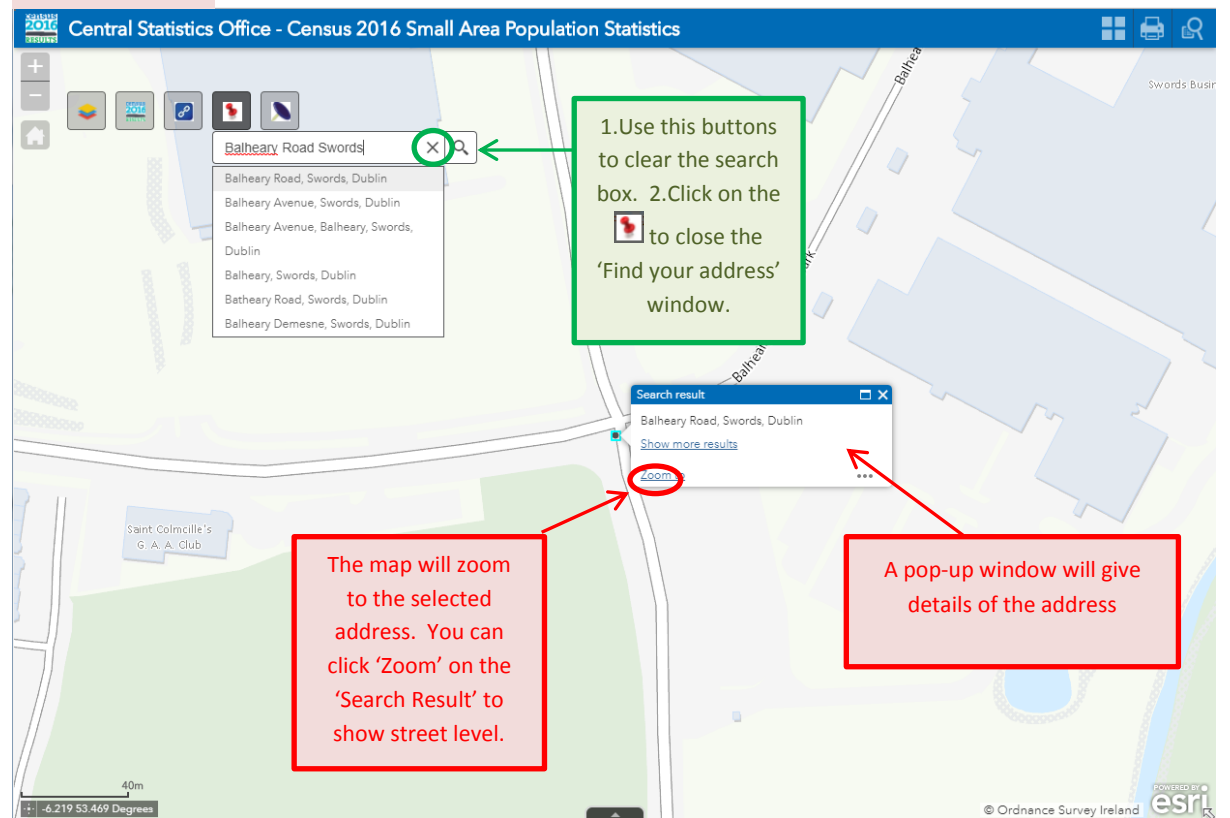






	CSO Boundary Layers	<p>With this function the user can select different layers of geographical areas to be displayed on the map along with census data relating to each area.</p>
	Go to other SapMaps	<p>This function allows the user to view other SAPMAP applications.</p>
	Useful Links	<p>This Function provides the user with quick links to SAPMAP Help, other SAPMAPs, Census Homepage, Census Reports, Census Boundary Files, CSO Homepage and CSO Latest Releases and Publications.</p>
	Find your address	<p>This function allows the user to search for an area on the map by inputting an address.</p>
	Find your area	<p>This function allows the user to select a boundary and search for an area on the map by inputting the area name.</p>
	Basemap Gallery	<p>This function allows the user to choose a new basemap from a gallery of basemaps. Click to select and the current basemap gets replaced by the new basemap. Click on basemap gallery to close.</p>
	Print	<p>This function allows the user to print the section of the map shown on the screen. Give it a title, define layout and choose format.</p>
	Select Multiple Areas	<p>This function allows the user to select multiple areas within a pre-defined layer. Select the layer, choose the tool you wish to use and click on map to select the areas you want to view and select execute. From the results tab select the three dots to give you options to view, export results etc.</p>

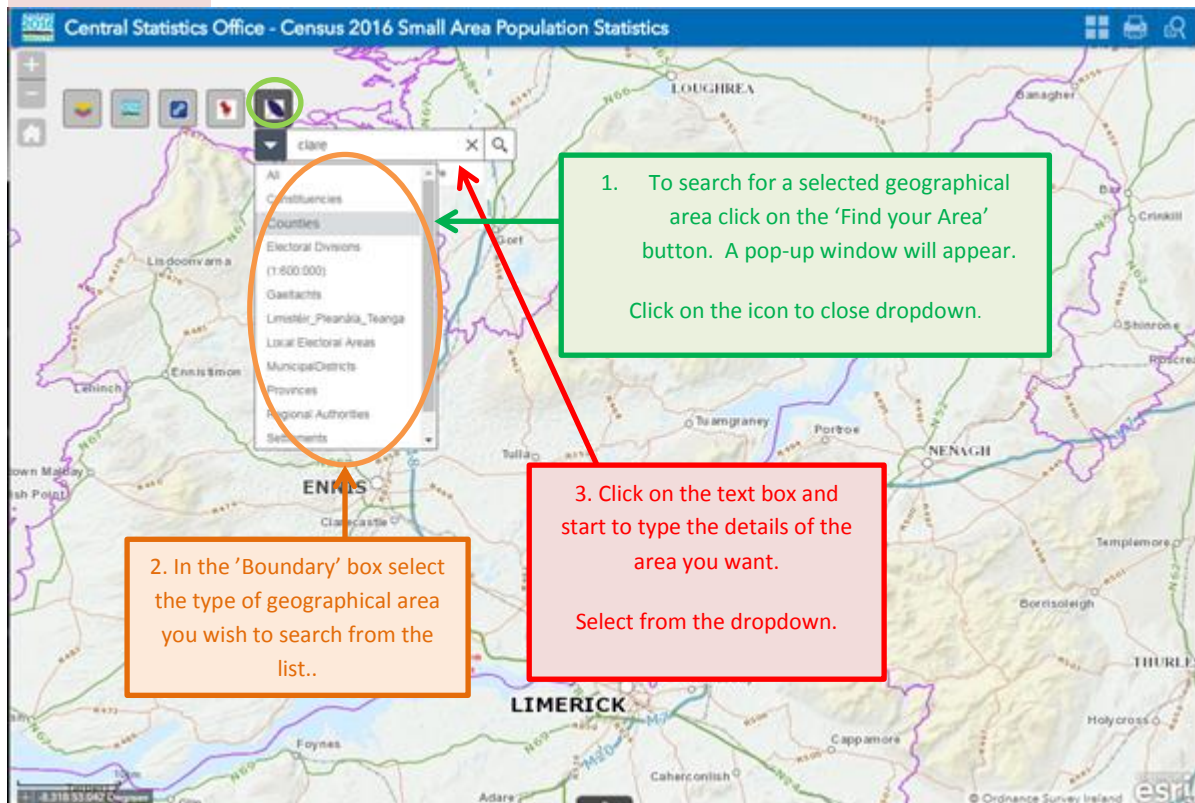

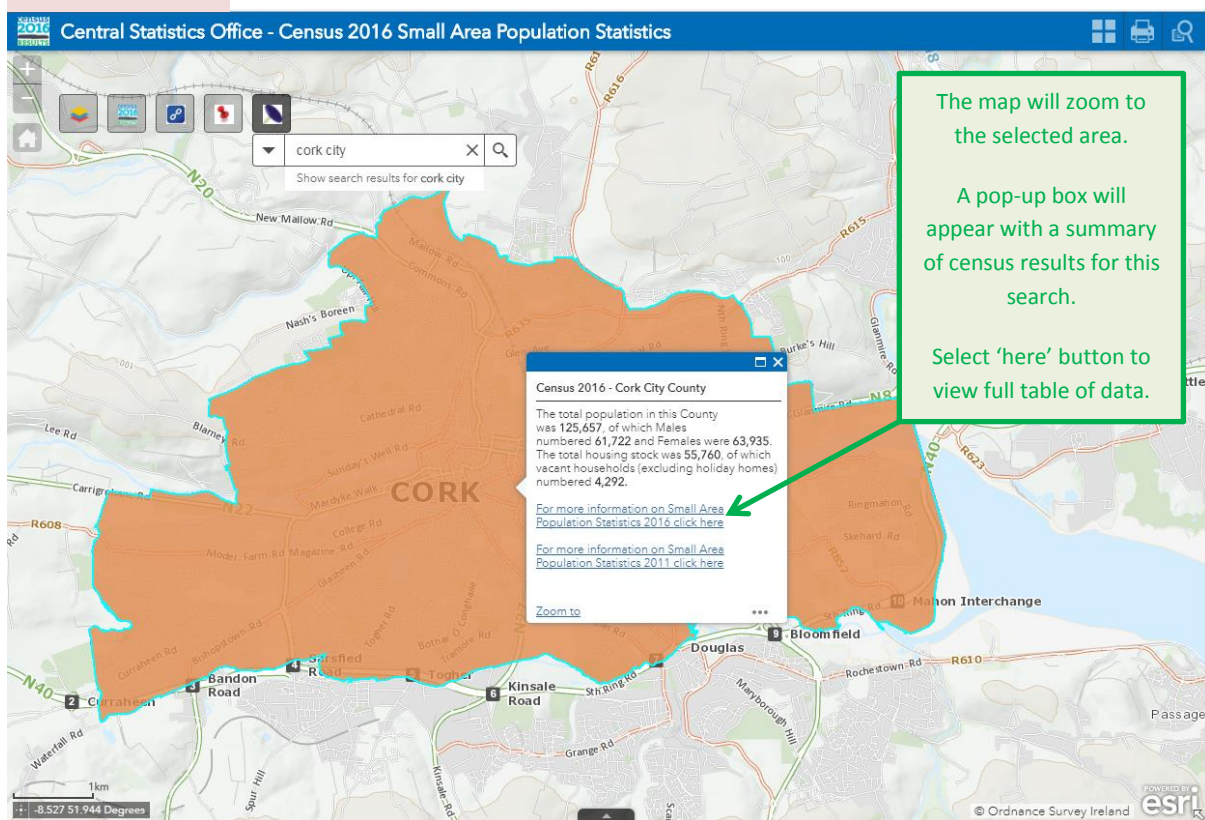

1. To see different geographical areas on the map click on the 'Census 2016 Boundaries' button.

A pop-up window will appear showing each of the geographical layers available to view.

3. Click on the ... to the right of any layer to view a number of options.

2. Select the geographical layer you wish to view by clicking the tick box to the left.

You may select more than one layer to see each superimposed on the map.

The county layer is selected by default.

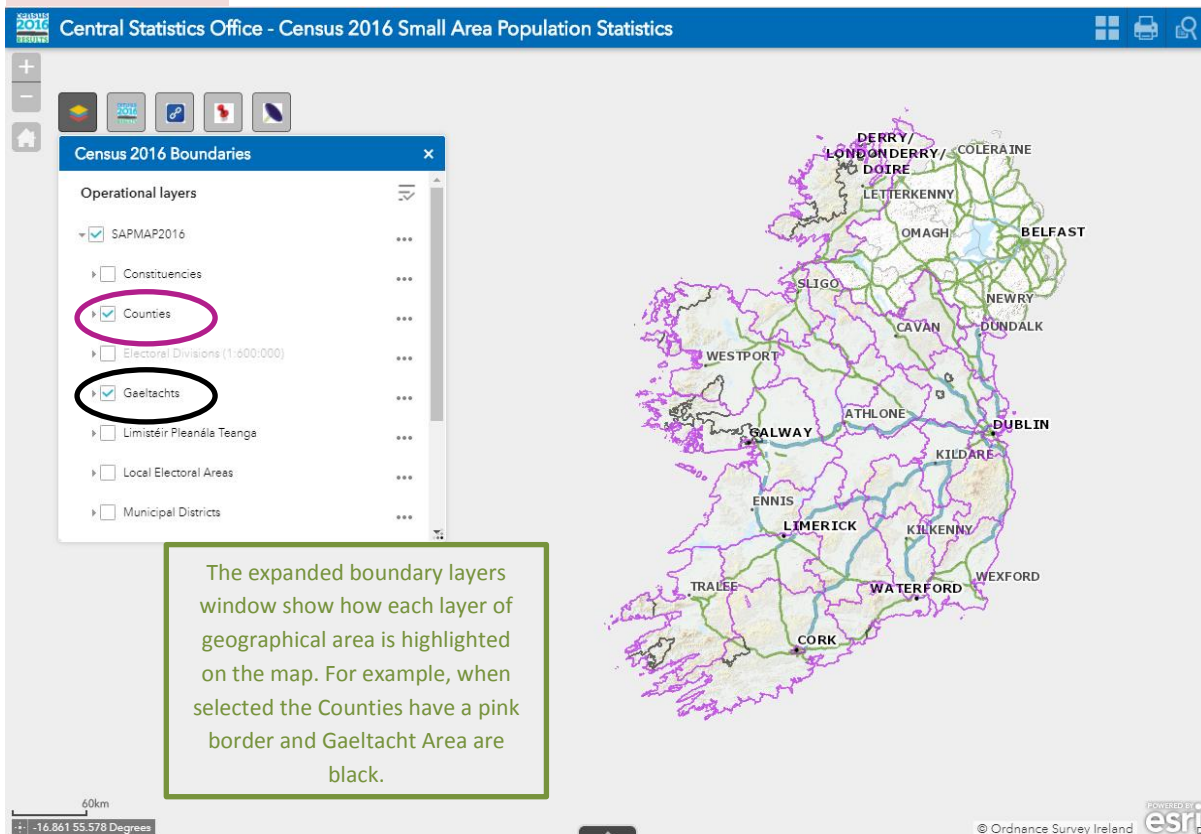
Just click again to de-select.

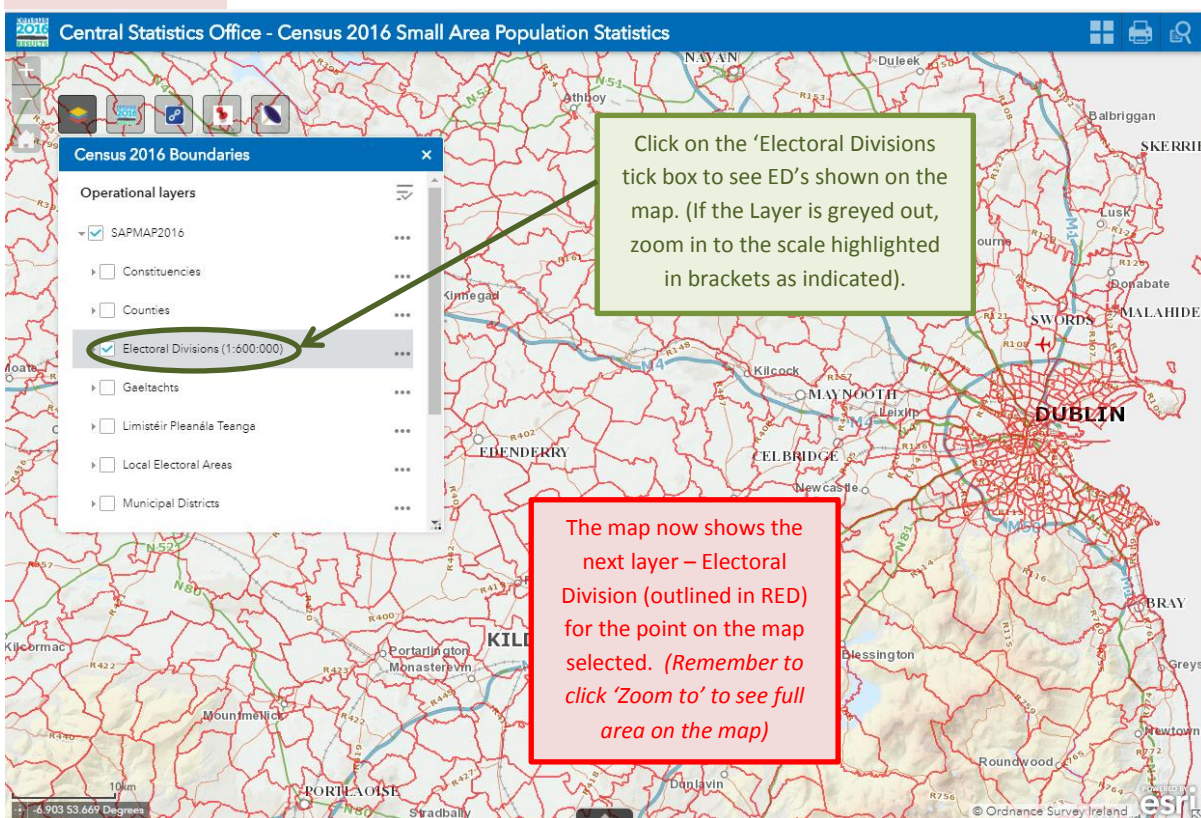

Click on the button to the right of any layer to see a number of options. Select 'Expand the layers' to see a legend for the layers on the map.

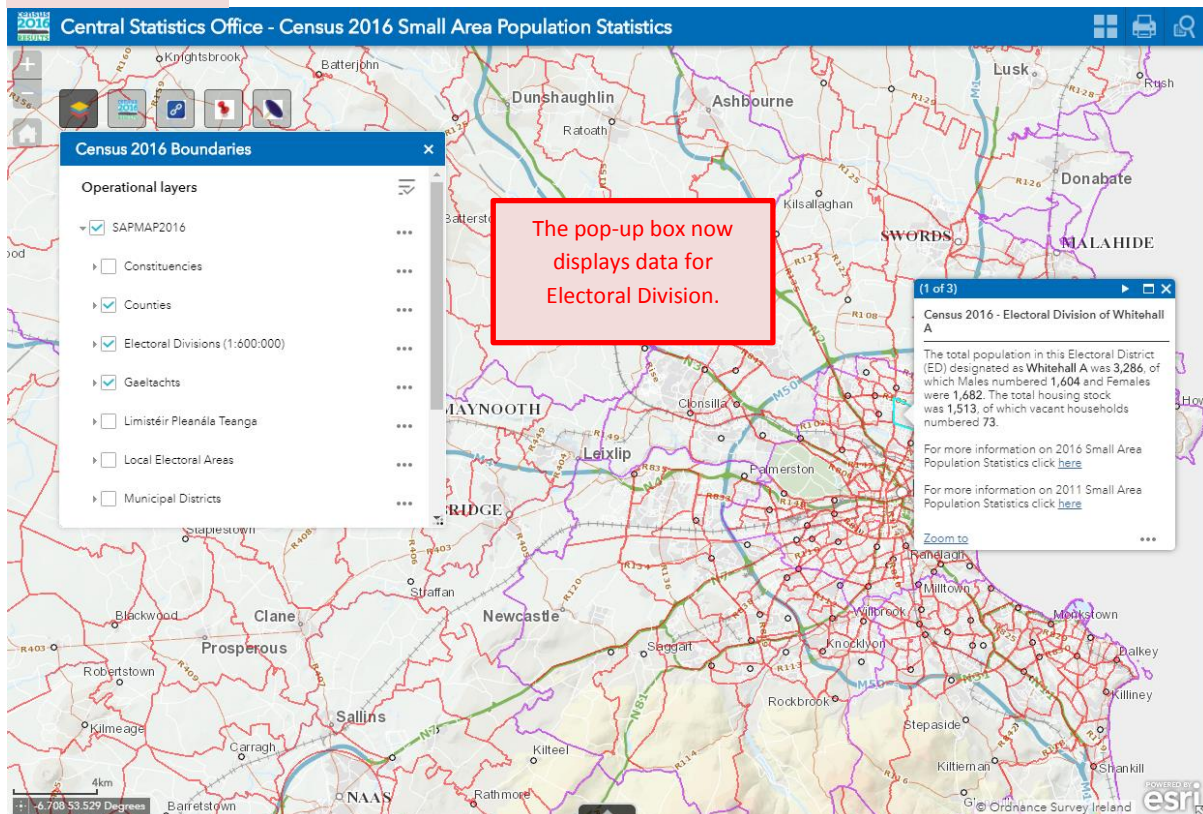
