

## 6 Glossary

<b>Accommodation</b>	House, flat, apartment, caravan or mobile home where people live
<b>Detached House</b>	A house that is standing on it's own
<b>Semi-detached House</b>	A house that is joined to another on one side only
<b>Terraced House</b>	One of a row of houses joined together
<b>Duplex</b>	Type of apartment, usually two-storey, that has it's own entrance
<b>Owner occupied house</b>	A house that is lived in by the person who is buying it or has bought it
<b>Local Authority</b>	For example the County Council
<b>Public Main</b>	Pipe from the main system that supplies a community
<b>Broadband</b>	High speed connection the Internet
<b>Annulment</b>	Formal cancellation of a marriage
<b>Ceased</b>	Ended
<b>Apprenticeship</b>	Learning a trade
<b>Vocational</b>	Training in a special skill for a job
<b>Voluntary work</b>	Offers work for free
<b>Nationality</b>	Usually the country where you were born and from which you have a passport.
