Who can take part?

Open to individuals, or teams of 2 or 3, from any part of the island of Ireland. Teachers must register the students.

How to take part:

- 1. Find a question
- 2. Collect or use existing data
- 3. Review data quality
- 4. Analyse the data
- 5. Make the poster

The poster can be about any topic; however, it should reflect or illustrate usage, analysis, interpretation and communication of statistics or statistical information.
