




Structure of Division - functions

Statistical data and legislative requirements

The CSO is Ireland's National Statistical Institute (NSI)

- an independent office Statistics Act, 1993
- sole contact point for the Commission (Eurostat) on statistical matters


Eurostat is the "Community statistical authority" (Regulation (EC) No 223/2009 (as amended 2015))

- ensuring the production of consistent, high quality, European statistics including government accounts, using detailed accounting rules and guidelines
- significant audit powers
 - data is scrutinised on a quarterly and biannual basis
 - Dialogue (audit) Visits to the CSO offices every two years (next one end May 2024)
- Local authority data always an area for scrutiny
- Action points arising from dialogue visits resulting in improvements in both LA returns via "B9 template" and continuing improvements in the LA entity data
 - DHLGH Assistant secretary communicated the importance of ensuring that the high-quality LA data is transmitted to the CSO and Eurostat






Domestic Institutional Sectors

Classification of entities

Government Accounts Classifications Division determines the statistical classification of the entities by assessing factors such as:

- is it an institutional unit?
- does it receive government funding?
- the level of control the local authority has over the entity

Establishes the statistical classification for all entities under the aegis of local authorities

- Non-commercial agency under the aegis of Local Government (S.1313)
- Commercial non-financial corporation (S.11001)
- Commercial financial corporation (S.12001)

The classification criteria comply with detailed European rules and guidelines



Aims of local authority online survey (eQ)

- To collect information of all entities under the aegis of local authorities
- Record any births and deaths within the financial year
- Assess local authority control using voting power (%)
- Analyse financial data for each entity
- Improve the timeliness of data from the current t+24 months to t+12 months
- All information legally required for national and European statistics




Benefits of eQ

- Individual eQ for each local authority
- Prefilled data, where possible
- Improve the timeliness of data
 - Central government eQ improved timeliness by 6 months
 - Aim to further improve the LA eQ
- Online eQ enables:
 - direct contact with relevant respondents
 - better breakdown of entities within the local authorities
- Positive feedback from users, quicker to complete, standardised terms



2023 survey

- 2023 was the first iteration of the LA online survey (eQ) covering 2021 financial data
- 100% response rate and significant improvement in data quality
- Some concern over the quality of aspects of the data
 - Consolidation status of the accounts of each entity
 - Income/expenditure/turnover figures for each entity
- These figures are necessary to complete a market (commercial) test and to accurately classify each entity as public/private
- Where data is not provided, entities will be classified in the local government sector
- Local Government chapter in <u>Register of Public Sector Bodies</u>






Pre-filled values
