Administrative Data Sources

- What are they used for?
 - Collected for an administrative purpose
 - Drive payments
 - Assess tax liability
 - Etc.
- Do they have any other potential uses?
 - As the basis for making decisions
 - Allows you to tell the story of change
 - As a means of evaluating effectiveness

Using Administrative Data

- CSO exploring potential of administrative data to support evidence based policy making
- SPAR project etc.
- Data linkage and integration
- Benefits:
 - Range, scope and depth of analysis possible
 - Positive impact on quality
 - Response burden

Context

- NSB Strategy 2003-2008, 2009-2014
- Whole system approach to Irish Statistical System
- Why? Benefits, Cost etc.
- NSB objectives/recommendations needs a collaborative/shared approach



Common purpose

- Trying to build a shared objective/common purpose
- Been difficult to achieve without tangible examples of real potential
- Good progress made but significant challenges remain
- Statistical infrastructure needs to be developed across public sector
- Before it can be built needs to be a recognition that it is required and will deliver "value-added"
