

# Crops and Livestock Survey June 2001 – Provisional Estimates

### Cattle numbers up 0.4% in June 2001

Preliminary estimates from the June 2001 agricultural survey show that the number of cattle (7,263,500) was up 0.4% on the previous year. The number of male cattle 2 years and over fell by 11.5% (91,100) and there was also a decrease of 8.9% (17,900) in the number of dairy heifers. However these decreases were offset by increases in other cows (25,800), female 2 years and over (23,500), female 1-2 years (33,600) and female under 1 year (29,800). See Table 2.

The area under the main cereals (wheat, oats and barley) increased by 700 ha (0.3%) to 283,300 ha. The area under winters cereals for 2001 has fallen (22,900 ha) but has been compensated for by an increase (23,700 ha) in the area under spring sown cereals. See Table 1 and Background Notes.

A comparison with the June 2000 provisional results indicates that:

- Sheep numbers decreased by 1.8% mainly due to a decrease of 180,900 in ewes.
- The area under potatoes fell 0.7% to 13,690 ha.

These results are provisional. Final figures will be available in Spring 2002 after the Census of Agriculture 2000 figures are published.




## **Background Notes**

**Introduction** This release presents provisional estimates of land utilisation and livestock numbers in June 2001 at State level. The estimates are based on returns from the June 2001 Crops and Livestock Survey.

Coverage

Farms where the agricultural area used was at least 1 hectare (2.47 acres) may be included in the June Agricultural Survey. Farms with less than 1 hectare may also be included if they were engaged in intensive production (e.g. pigs, poultry).

**Results** The results are based on the trends between June 2000 and June 2001 obtained by comparing the returns from the 2000 Census of Agriculture with the 2001 returns for the same 12,200 farms. However a significant number of the June 2001 returns have not yet been processed due to the work on the Census of Agriculture. These figures will be revised when the final results of the Census of Agriculture 2000 are published and the remaining June 2001 forms are processed.

As the figures in the text and tables have been rounded to the nearest 100 units there may be slight discrepancies between the sum (or difference) of the constituent items and the total shown. Percentage changes have been calculated on actual figures.

**Technical Note** Winter cereals are defined as those crops which are planted before the end of December. However in 2000/2001 due to adverse weather conditions some winter variety cereals were planted in January. Therefore there may have been some confusion over the differentiation between the variety of seed (winter or spring) and the date of planting (2000 or 2001).
