## Pig numbers down 3.0%

The total number of pigs in December 2006 is estimated at 1,620,000. This represents a decrease of 3.0% since December 2005. (*See Table 1*).

Breeding pigs were down 4.6% and non-breeding pigs down 2.9%. (See Table 1).

A comparison of the December 2005 and December 2006 figures (*See Table 1*) shows that in the breeding category:

- Other sows for breeding decreased by 11.6%.
- Sows in pig decreased by 3.7%.

EU pig population figures show an increase of 0.4% in December 2005 compared to December 2004. (*See page 4*).

### Revision of pig figures 2001 - 2005


Table 2 of this release contains revised results for the years 2001 onwards in the 'other pigs' category, together with smaller amendments in the 'breeding pigs' category from 2004 onwards.

The revisions reflect an improved approach to recording the detailed sub-categories of the pig population from June 2006 onwards. While some retrospective adjustments have been made, there is still a discontinuity before and after June 2006

# **Background Notes**

- **Introduction** This release presents estimates of numbers of pigs in December 2006 at State level. The estimates are based on returns from the December 2006 Pig Survey.
  - **Coverage** 383 specialised pig farms were included in the survey for December 2006, accounting for 92% of the total pig population.
    - **Results** The results are calculated using a grossing methodology.

As figures in the text and tables have been rounded to the nearest 100 units there may be slight discrepancies between the sum (or difference) of the constituent items and the totals shown.
