

Further drop in Live Register

At the end of September there were 186,183 persons signing on the Live Register, a decrease of 12,487 on the previous month.

The Live Register usually decreases in September due to seasonal factors; when these are taken into account the underlying monthly trend was a fall of 5,100.

In the year to September 1999 the Live Register decreased by almost 33,000 persons, a fall of 15%. Just over 70% of this annual decrease was for men. *See Table 1a.*

Other features include:

- ◆ The majority of the decrease in September was for female registrants (-7,663). *See Table 1a*.
- ♦ The number of persons under 25 years of age signing on decreased by 3,085 in the month; the number aged 25 years and over decreased by 9,402. See tables 1b and 1c.
- ♦ While all regions decreased in the month, the smallest percentage decrease (4%) was in the Border region. *See Table 2*.
- ◆ The Standardised Unemployment Rate for September was 6.2%, a decline of 0.2% on August. *See Table 8*.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figures are, Dec-Feb 1998/99, 95,100.

Background Notes

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. It comprises persons **Live Register** under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders and selfemployed persons (see Table 5);
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 5).

Descriptive The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

Unemployment Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey (formerly the annual Labour Force Survey). The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit.

unemployment

Standardised The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 7 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the labour force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys. This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996.

> The monthly SUR series was resumed in October 1997. A linear interpolation estimation approach has been used between April 1996 and April 1997, as it is considered that the Live Register series cannot be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during this period. The traditional estimation approach is used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are: Sep-Nov 1997, 10.4%; Dec-Feb 1997/98, 8.5%; Mar-May 1998, 7.8%; Jun-Aug 1998, 7.6%; Sep-Nov 1998, 6.4% and Dec-Feb 1998/99, 5.8%.

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 3a, b and c the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May 1998 unemployment rate, which is directly comparable with April LFS data, has been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.
