

Less than 20,000 days lost in the second quarter

There were 10 industrial disputes, involving 13,099 workers, in the second quarter of 2001. The number of days lost, 19,706, compares to 3,115 days lost in the corresponding quarter of 2000.

The manufacturing sector accounted for 43% of the days lost. The other sectors affected were wholesale and retail trade, transport, storage and communication and health and social work. See table 1.

In the first six months of 2001 there were 110,133 days lost due to industrial disputes. This is greater than the annual total for 2000, when 97,046 days were lost. In the first six months of 2000, 26,353 days were lost. See graph and table 2.

Background Notes

- **Sources** The information on Industrial Disputes is based on details supplied by the Monitoring Unit of the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment and on information collected directly from other sources by the Central Statistics Office.
 - **Scope** Disputes are included in this release if they involve a stoppage of work lasting for at least one day and the total time lost is 10 or more person–days.
- **Days Lost** In calculating days lost, it is assumed that work would have continued if no dispute had occurred. No allowance is made for loss of work from unemployment or other causes (such as bad weather) which might have happened even if there was no dispute. The number of days lost is calculated by multiplying the number of persons involved by the number of normal working days during which they were involved in the dispute. Persons working for approximately 40 hours per week are assumed to be working the equivalent of a 5 day week even if the work is spread over more than 5 days.
- **Disputes in Progress** The tables show data on disputes which began and disputes which were in progress in each quarter. The quarterly figures for the number of disputes in progress and for the number of firms and workers involved will not always add to the annual total, since an industrial dispute can be in progress in more than one quarter.
