

# Number of households increases by 70,000 between 1998 and 2001

The estimated number of private households increased by almost 70,000 (+5.7%) from 1,221,000 in the second quarter of 1998 to 1,290,600 in the second quarter of 2001. The fastest growing regions were the Mid-East and the West where the number of households increased by 10.7% and 9.2% respectively over the period. See graph, background notes and tables A1 to A4.

#### More mothers at work

Almost 50% of women living with a husband/partner in a family unit with children were in employment in June–August 2001 compared with 43.6% three years earlier. The most notable increase in employment participation was for mothers in family units where the youngest child was aged 5 to 14. In this category the percentage in employment increased from 47.0% to 56.2% between mid-1998 and mid-2001.


In absolute terms the number of employed mothers living in family units with children (including lone mothers) increased by over 50,000 between 1998 and 2001. The number of working wives/partners living in family units without children also increased by 21,000 over the period.

#### **Background**

This release presents information on private households and family units that have not been available as a standard output from the QNHS until now. Tables A1 to A4 provide annual estimates of the number of households in each Regional Authority, classified by size of household, for the second quarter of each of the years 1998 to 2001 inclusive. Tables B1 to B16 provide quarterly estimates of the adult members of family units, classified by composition of family unit, ILO economic status and sex, for each quarter since the survey commenced in September 1997. Corresponding data were published in the annual Labour Force Survey reports up to 1997. *See background notes*.

#### Percentage of lone parents in employment



### Over 45% of all lone parents in employment

Of the 178,100 persons classified as lone parents in the third quarter of 2001, 81,100 or 45.5% were in employment. This compares with 37.9% in the third quarter of 1998. Almost 55% of male lone parents had a job in 2001 compared with 44% of female lone parents. *See tables B1 to B16*.

The lone parent category includes widows and widowers who form a family unit with some or all of their children. They are most likely to be older and concentrated in family units where all children are 15 years or older. In the third quarter of 2001 only a third of the lone parents with older children were in employment.

In the case of parents with younger children, over 47% of lone parents with children under 5 were in employment compared with almost 65% of those whose youngest child was aged 5 to 14.

### **Background Notes**

#### **Purpose of Survey**

The Quarterly National Household Survey (QNHS) began in September 1997, replacing the annual April Labour Force Survey (LFS). The purpose of the survey is the production of quarterly labour force estimates and occasional reports on social topics. The survey meets the requirements of Council Regulation (EC) No. 577/98, adopted in March 1998, which requires the introduction of quarterly labour force surveys in EU Member States.

## Data Collection and Reference Period

Information is collected continuously throughout the year, with 3,000 households surveyed each week to give a total sample of 39,000 households in each quarter. Information is collected on laptop computers, using computer-assisted personal interview (CAPI) software. The reference quarters for survey results are: Q1 - December to February, Q2 - March to May, Q3 - June to August and Q4 - September to November.

#### **Definitions**

#### **Private Household**

A private household, for the purposes of the QNHS, is defined to be any one person or group of persons (not necessarily related) with common housekeeping arrangements, separately occupying all or part of a private house, flat, apartment or other private habitation.

There is an important difference between the details for private households given in this report and those compiled in the Censuses of Population. The census figures are based on where individuals spent Census night (a Sunday night in April) whereas the Quarterly National Household Survey is based on where persons are "usually resident". As some households will be absent from their usual residence on Census night, (e.g. visiting another household, staying in a hotel, etc.), the number of private households recorded by a Census is always somewhat lower than that which would be estimated by the QNHS.

#### **Family Unit**

A family unit consists of either:

- 1. a married couple, or
- 2. a married couple and one or more of their never-married children, or
- 3. one parent and one or more of his or her never-married children, or
- 4. a couple living together (with never-married children, if any) who are not married to each other, where it is clear that the couple form a "de facto" family unit.

Households may contain more than one family unit or may contain a family together with other persons not in a family unit as defined above.

However, there are problems identifying some unmarried parents with children as separate family units. This happens particularly where one unmarried parent with one or more children lives with his/her parent(s) and the information recorded in the survey on the relationship to the reference person does not clearly identify the parent/child relationships. In such cases, the unmarried parent and children may not be identified as a distinct family unit. As a result, the number of family units consisting of unmarried parents with children is probably understated to some degree.

#### **Grossing Effect**

The QNHS grossing procedure aligns the distribution of persons covered in the survey with independently determined population estimates at the level of sex, five-year age group and region. This means that the adjustment factors assigned to each spouse within a family unit will differ. Accordingly, some male and female estimates in family tables, which might be expected to be identical, differ slightly. Another factor effecting the slight difference is that, in a small number of cases gender was incorrectly recorded or coded.

#### Region

West

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. The composition of the regions is set out below.
