

Just over 21,000 days lost to industrial disputes in 2002

During 2002, there were 21,257 days lost to industrial disputes. This is the lowest annual total going back as far as 1970.

The 2002 total represents a sharp fall from the 114,613 days lost in 2001. The total days lost in 2002 remain significantly less than the total days lost in 2001 even if one allows for the impact the teachers' dispute had on the 2001 figures.

There were 27 industrial disputes in 2002, all of which began in the year. The 27 disputes in progress in 2002 affected 3,553 workers and 43 firms. *See table 3*.

Other features include:

- In 2002 the *Manufacturing* industry accounted for 8,989 (42.3%) of the total days lost, with the *Health and social work* area accounting for another 5,465 (25.7%). *See table 2*.
- The 3,355 days lost in quarter four of 2002 compares to 670 days lost in the fourth quarter of 2001. *See table 3*.
- The 5 industrial disputes in progress in the fourth quarter of 2002 involved 352 workers and 5 organisations. *See table 1*.

Central Statistics Office Industrial Disputes

Background Notes

The information on Industrial Disputes is based on details supplied by the Monitoring Unit of the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment and on information collected directly from other sources by the Central Statistics Office.

Scope Disputes are included in this release if they involve a stoppage of work lasting for at least one day and the total time lost is 10 or more person-days.

Days Lost In calculating days lost, it is assumed that work would have continued if no dispute had occurred. No allowance is made for loss of work from unemployment or other causes (such as bad weather) which might have happened even if there was no dispute. The number of days lost is calculated by multiplying the number of persons involved by the number of normal working days during which they were involved in the dispute. Persons working for approximately 40 hours per week are assumed to be working the equivalent of a 5 day week even if the work is spread over more than 5 days.

Disputes in Progress

The tables show data on disputes which began and disputes which were in progress in each quarter. The quarterly figures for the number of disputes in progress and for the number of firms and workers involved will not always add to the annual total, since an industrial dispute can be in progress in more than one quarter.

Reference Quarters

The reference quarters for Industrial Disputes results are:

Q1 - January to March, Q2 - April to June, Q3 - July to September and Q4 - October to December.
