

# Live Register Analysis

## Increase of 3,800 after seasonal adjustment

The Live Register decreased by 85 persons in March to 162,252. After adjusting for seasonal factors, the Live Register showed an increase of 3,800 in the month. The seasonally adjusted total increased from 160,800 in February to 164,600 in March.

In the year to March 2002, the Live Register increased by 26,367 persons to 162,252.

Other features include:

- During March the decrease of 85 reflected a decrease of 1,032 males and an increase of 947 females. The monthly increase of 3,800 in the seasonally adjusted figure comprised an increase of 1,200 males and 2,600 females. *See tables 1 and 2*.
- The annual increase of 26,367 comprised an increase of 17,240 males and 9,127 females. *See table 1*.
- The standardised unemployment rate in March was 4.3%. This compares with 3.7% in April 2001, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. *See table 3 and background notes*.
- In the month the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 8,756 males and 12,102 females. *See background notes*


The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for September - November 2001 is 72,600 persons unemployed.

## Monthly decreases in two regions

The monthly decrease of 85 persons on the Live Register reflected increases in six regions and decreases in two regions (the Mid-East and the South-West). The largest monthly decrease was in the South-West (-4.6%).

In the year to March 2002, the Live Register increased in all regions. The overall national increase was 19.4%. The largest annual percentage increases were in the Mid-East (+32.7%) and in the Dublin (+28.2%) regions. *See table 4*.

Other regional features include:

- During March, the number of male claimants increased slightly in Dublin and the Mid-West and decreased in all other regions. *See table 4*.
- The number of female claimants increased in all regions with the exception of the South-West where it decreased. *See table 4*.

## Outflows exceed new registrations

A total of 29,785 persons joined the Live Register in March 2002. This was offset by 29,870 persons leaving the Register giving a net decrease of 85 persons in the month. This compares with a monthly decrease of 3,630 in March 2001.

Other attributes include:

- The Live Register decreased on average by 17 persons per week during March 2002. In comparison there was an average weekly decrease of 726 persons one year previously. See table 8.
- In March 2002, there were on average 5,957 new claimants per week and 5,974 persons leaving the Register. This compares to a weekly average of 4,394 new claimants and 5,120 persons leaving the Live Register in March 2001. *See table 8*.
- On average, the number of male registrants decreased by 206 per week, while the number of female registrants increased by 189 per week. See table 9.

# **Background Notes**

**Source and** The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. It comprises persons **Live Register** under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 10)
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons (see Table 11)
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 11).

# Descriptive

The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

# statistics

**Unemployment** The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those ho work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National House**hold Survey** (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

## Standardised unemployment

The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate . The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

**Seasonal** The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Bureau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May unemployment rates, which are directly comparable with April LFS data, have been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.

time workers

Casual and part The casual and part time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.

Flow Analysis

**History of** The flow analysis of the Live Register had been published monthly as a separate release since January 1989. Similar details were previously included in the Industrial Analysis of the Live Register, which was discontinued.

Live Register Changes in the level of flows on and off the Live Register in any month reflect conditions in the Flow Analysis labour market and aspects of the social insurance system such as transfers to or from other welfare schemes, exhaustion of Unemployment Benefit (UB) entitlement without qualifying for Unemployment Assistance (UA) etc.

**New registrations** 

The aggregate of new registrations for each Friday in a given month is used in conjunction with the net change over the same period to calculate the outflow from the register. A new registration is defined as anybody on the Live Register on a particular Friday who was not on it on the previous Friday.

Area Analysis

Live Register The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not correspond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not necessarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.

**NUTS2** and NUTS3 regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. See overleaf.
