

Unadjusted Live Register decreases in May

The Live Register decreased by 1,293 persons in the month to 154,944. The change for the year to May 2002, shows an increase of 21,253.

The seasonally adjusted total increased from 159,000 in April to 161,300 in May, an increase of 2,300.

Other features include:

- ♦ During May the decrease of 1,293 reflected a decrease of 1,422 males and an increase of 129 females. The monthly increase of 2,300 in the seasonally adjusted figure comprised increases of 1,900 females and 400 males. See tables 1 and 2a.
- ◆ The annual increase of 21,253 comprised increases of 14,696 males and 6,557 females. *See table 1*.
- ♦ The standardised unemployment rate in May was 4.2%. This compares with 3.7% in April 2001, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. See table 3 and background notes.
- ♦ In the month the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 8,252 males and 11,707 females. *See background notes*.


The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for December - February 2002 is 80,000 persons unemployed.

Monthly decreases in four regions

The monthly decrease of 1,293 persons on the Live Register reflected decreases in four of the eight regions. The decreases totalled 1,534 and the increases totalled 241. The largest monthly decrease was in the South-West (-665), while the largest monthly increase was in the Border region (+112).

In the year to May 2002, the Live Register increased in all regions. The overall national increase was 15.9%. The largest annual percentage increases were in the Mid-East (+29.3%) and Dublin (+24.2%) regions. *See table 4*.

Other regional features include:

- ◆ In May, the number of male claimants increased slightly in the Mid-West and Border and decreased in all other regions. *See table 4*.
- ◆ The number of female claimants increased in all regions in the month with the exception of the South-East and South-West regions where the numbers decreased. *See table 4*.

A total of 25,082 persons joined the Live Register in May 2002. This was offset by 26,375 persons leaving the Register giving a net decrease of 1,293 persons in the month. This compares with a monthly decrease of 2,870 in May 2001.

Other attributes include:

- ◆ The Live Register decreased on average by 259 persons per week during May 2002. See table 8.
- ♦ In May 2002, there were on average 5,016 new claimants per week and 5,275 persons leaving the Register. *See table 8*.
- On average, the number of male registrants decreased by 284 per week, while the number of female registrants increased by 26 per week. See table 9.

Background Notes

Live Register

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. It comprises persons under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 10)
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons (see Table 11)
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 11).

Descriptive The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl.7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

statistics

Unemployment The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those ho work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National House**hold Survey** (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

unemployment

Standardised The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

> This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

> Because QNHS estimates are not yet adjusted for seasonality, only the March-May unemployment rates, which are directly comparable with April LFS data, have been incorporated in the calculation of the monthly SUR.

time workers

Casual and part The casual and part time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.

Flow Analysis

History of The flow analysis of the Live Register had been published monthly as a separate release since January 1989. Similar details were previously included in the Industrial Analysis of the Live Register, which was discontinued.

Live Register Changes in the level of flows on and off the Live Register in any month reflect conditions in the Flow Analysis labour market and aspects of the social insurance system such as transfers to or from other welfare schemes, exhaustion of Unemployment Benefit (UB) entitlement without qualifying for Unemployment Assistance (UA) etc.

New registrations

The aggregate of new registrations for each Friday in a given month is used in conjunction with the net change over the same period to calculate the outflow from the register. A new registration is defined as anybody on the Live Register on a particular Friday who was not on it on the previous Friday.

Area Analysis

Live Register The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social, Community and Family Affairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not correspond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not necessarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.

NUTS2 and NUTS3 regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. See overleaf.
