

10% of adults of working age have a longstanding health problem or disability

Over 10% (271,000) of all persons aged 15 to 64 indicated that they had a longstanding health problem or disability. Approximately 11% (142,700) of males reported having a health problem or disability compared to 10% (128,300) of females.

Not surprisingly the prevalence of health problems and disabilities varied by age, with a quarter (84,400) of all persons in the 55 to 64 year age group suffering from a longstanding health problem or disability. This compares to less than 5% (30,600) of persons in the 15 to 24 year age category.

Incidences of longstanding health problems/disabilities were also higher in proportional terms for separated and widowed persons at 21.9% and 23.6% respectively. These results are from the Quarterly National Household Survey module on Disability, which was asked in the March to May quarter of 2002. *See table 1 and background notes*.

40% of those with disability/health problem at work

Just over 40% (108,600) of all persons aged 15 to 64 with a disability/health problem indicated that they were in employment which compares to an overall rate of 65% for the total population in the same age category.

In relation to persons reporting a disability/health problem the 25 to 34 year age category had the highest percentage in employment at 55.6%. The lowest rate, 27.0%, was reported in the 55 to 64 age group. The equivalent figures for the total population in employment also showed the 25 to 34 year age group having the highest rate at 81.3%. The lowest rate was found in the 15 to 24 year age group at 45.3%. *See table 3*.

Of the 108,600 persons in employment suffering from health problems/disabilities, over three-quarters (81,700) were in full-time employment. The majority of those in employment were employees (87,600) with just over 20,000 falling into the self-employed and assisting relatives categories. *See table 4*.



Agriculture, forestry and fishing sector has highest proportion of workers with disability/health problems

Just over 9% of workers aged 15 to 64 in the *Agriculture, forestry and fishing* sector reported having a long standing health problem or disability. Other sectors with similar levels included *Health* (8.3%), *Other sectors* (7.9%), *Public administration and defence* (7.6%) and *Education* (7.5%). The *Construction* sector had the lowest representation in proportional terms with just 5.5% of workers reporting a disability/health problem. *See table 4*.

In terms of occupation, almost 10% of workers in the *Other* occupational category reported having a disability/health problem compared to 7.7% in the *Personal and Protective Service* group and 7.2% in the *Managers and Administrators* occupational group. Only 5% of the *Professional* category reported having a disability/health problem. *See table 4 and graph*.

Average hours worked vary with disability/illness

Persons reporting a disability/health problem worked on average 36.1 hours a week compared to 37.7 hours a week for the total population in employment in the same age category.

Persons suffering from Mental, nervous or emotional difficulties and persons with Other progressive illnesses tended to work on average for 31.8 and 33.1 hours a week respectively. This compared to an average of 38.0 hours worked a week by persons with Hearing difficulties and 38.5 hours a week worked by persons with Seeing difficulties. *See table 6*.

Chest and breathing problems top the list

The most commonly reported disabilities/longstanding health problems were Chest or breathing problems (41,500) followed by Heart, blood pressure or circulation problems (39,200) and Back or neck problems (37,800).

This pattern was also reflected among disabled persons in employment with 21,000 reporting Chest or breathing problems, 16,100 reporting Back or neck problems and 15,900 suffering from Heart, blood pressure or circulation problems.

Almost 51% of those with Chest or breathing related problems were in employment compared to rates of 42.6% and 40.6% for Back or neck problems and Heart, blood pressure or circulation problems respectively. *See tables 5 and 6.*

Chest or breathing problems were more common among younger persons while Heart, blood pressure or circulation problems were more prevalent among older persons. It should be noted that respondents were asked to pick their main long-standing health problem/disability and multiple responses were not allowed. *See table 5 and background notes*.

Nearly a third of disabled persons have been disabled for 10 or more years

Approximately 15% (40,500) of all persons with a disability/longstanding health problem have had their condition since birth. Just under a third (84,900) have had their condition for ten years or more. The pattern for the 108,600 disabled persons in employment is similar; with just under 15% (15,800) having had their disability/health problem since birth and a further 30% (31,800) for ten years or more. See tables 7 and 8.

The most common causes of disability/longstanding health problems were non-work related diseases (72,500) and birth related injuries/born with condition (45,900). Of the disabled persons in employment, 9,300 persons stated that their

disability was a result of a work-related disease and a further 5,700 stated that their disability was a result of a work-related accident. *See tables 9 and 10.*

Less than half of all disabled persons in employment indicated that their disability restricted the kind of work that they could undertake. The degree to which individuals were restricted varied significantly based on the nature of the illness/disability. Almost 76% of those with Back or neck related disabilities and 68% with Mental, nervous or emotional illnesses/disabilities were restricted in the kind of work they could do compared to 21% with Diabetes and 27% with Stomach, liver, kidney, digestive illnesses/disabilities.

Almost 42% (45,400) of disabled persons in employment stated that their condition restricted the amount of work they could do. Again the rates varied by illness/disability with approximately 65% of those with Arms or hands, Back or neck and Mental, nervous or emotional illnesses/disabilities reporting that the amount of work they could do was affected. *See table 12*.

Assistance provided to disabled persons in employment

Assistance was provided to 8,900 (or 8.2%) of the 108,600 persons in employment who reported a longstanding health problem or disability. Just over 3,000 worked in sheltered or supported employment. Almost 22,000 persons with a disability or longstanding health problem not in employment stated that they would require assistance in order to work. *See tables 13 and 14*.

Background Notes

Reference period

The questions on disability were included in the Quarterly National Household Survey (QNHS) in the three months from March to May 2002.

Purpose of survey

While the primary purpose of the QNHS is to collect information on employment and unemployment, it also includes modules on social topics of interest from time to time.

Questionnaire

The disability module was asked to all persons aged between 15 and 64 years inclusively.

Longstanding health problem or disability

A longstanding health problem or disability refers to anything that has affected respondent over the past 6 months, or that is likely to affect respondent for at least 6 months.

Type of longstanding health problem or disability

If the respondent answered yes to having a longstanding health problem or disability, they were asked the following question. Which of the following categories would best describe your health condition?

- 1. Problems with arms or hands (which include arthritis or rheumatism)
- 2. Problems with legs or feet (which include arthritis or rheumatism)
- 3. Problems with back or neck (which include arthritis or rheumatism)
- 4. Difficulty with seeing
- 5. Difficulty with hearing
- 6. Speech impediment
- 7. Skin conditions (including disfigurement or allergies)
- 8. Chest or breathing problems (including asthma or bronchitis)
- 9. Heart, blood pressure or circulation problems
- 10. Stomach, liver, kidney or digestive problems
- 11. Diabetes
- 12. Epilepsy
- 13. Mental, nervous or emotional problems
- 14. Other progressive illnesses (including cancers, MS, HIV, Parkinsons disease etc.)
- 15. Other longstanding health problems
- 16. Refusal.

Economic Status

The ILO Economic Status used in these results distinguishes the following main subgroups of the population aged 15 to 64.

In Employment: Persons who worked in the week before the survey for one hour or more for payment or profit, including work on the family farm or business and all persons who had a job but were not at work because of illness, holidays etc. in the week.

Unemployed: Persons who, in the week before the survey, were without work and available for work and had taken specific steps, in the preceding four weeks, to find work.

Inactive Population (not in labour force): All other persons.

The labour force comprises persons employed plus unemployed.

Regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. The composition of the regions is set out below.
