Live Register increases in July

The Live Register increased by 7,595 (4.3%) persons in July to 185,447. This compares to an increase of 7,821 (4.8%) for July of last year. When seasonal factors are taken into account the seasonally adjusted total rose from 176,200 in June to 178,500 this month, a rise of 2,300 (+1.3%). *See table 2a and graph opposite.*

In the year to July 2003 there was an increase of 13,349 (+7.8%). This compares to an annual increase of 24,997 (+17.0%) in the year to July 2002 and to an annual increase last month, June 2003, of 13,575 (+8.3%).

Other features include:


- The monthly increase of 7,595 comprised increases of 5,579 females and 2,016 males. *See table 1a.*
- ◆ The monthly increase in the Seasonally Adjusted series of 2,300 comprised increases of 1,900 females and 400 males. The increase in females was comprised of 400 aged under 25 and 1,500 aged over 25 while the increase for males was comprised of 100 and 300 respectively. *See table 2a, 2b and 2c.*
- ◆ The standardised unemployment rate in July was 4.8%. This compares with 4.2% in April 2002, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. *See table 3 and background notes*
- In the month the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 8,811 males and 12,886 females. *See background notes*.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest figure, for December to February 2003 is 84,900 persons unemployed.

Monthly increases in all regions

The monthly increase of 7,595 persons on the Live Register reflected increases in all regions. The largest percentage increases were in the Midland (+6.7%) and Mid-East (+6.6%) regions. The lowest regional increases were in the Border (+3.4%) and South-West (+3.0%).

Other area features in the month include:

- ◆ The number of males increased in all regions. The largest increases were in the Midland (+4.4%) and Mid-East (+3.3%) regions. The lowest regional increases were in the South-East (+0.9%) and the South-West (+0.4%).
- ♦ The number of females increased in all regions. The largest increases were in the Mid-East (+10.4%) and Midland (+9.3%) regions while the lowest regional increases were in the Border (+5.6%) and West (+6.4%).
- ♦ There were monthly increases in all counties. The largest were in Meath (+8.2%) and Westmeath (+8.1%). The lowest increases occurred in Waterford (+1.2%) and Mayo (+2.1%). See tables 4 and 6.

New registrations greater than outflows

A total of 27,917 persons joined the Live Register in July 2003. With 20,322 persons leaving the Register there is a net increase of 7,595 persons in the month.

Other features of the flows on and off the Register include:

- The average weekly increase of 1,899 in the Live Register was comprised of 1,395 females and 504 males. *See tables 8 and 9.*
- In the month there were weekly averages of 6,979 new claimants joining the Register and 5,081 persons leaving. *See table 8.*



Background Notes

Live Register

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social and Family Affairs. It comprises persons under 65 years of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers (see Table 10)
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons (see Table 11)
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute (see Table 11).
- **Descriptive** The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the articles September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl.7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.
- **Unemployment** The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those who statistics work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

Standardised The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number unemployment of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemrates ployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for April of each year are calculated from the Labour Force Survey/Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register has been traditionally used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

> This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (unadjusted for seasonality) are:

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Buadjustment reau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

Casual and part time workers	The casual and part time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.
History of Flow Analysis	The flow analysis of the Live Register had been published monthly as a separate release since Jan- uary 1989. Similar details were previously included in the Industrial Analysis of the Live Regis- ter, which was discontinued.
Live Register Flow Analysis	Changes in the level of flows on and off the Live Register in any month reflect conditions in the labour market and aspects of the social insurance system such as transfers to or from other welfare schemes, exhaustion of Unemployment Benefit (UB) entitlement without qualifying for Unemployment Assistance (UA) etc.
New registrations	The aggregate of <i>new registrations</i> for each Friday in a given month is used in conjunction with the <i>net change</i> over the same period to calculate the <i>outflow</i> from the register. A <i>new registration</i> is defined as anybody on the Live Register on a particular Friday who was not on it on the previous Friday.
Live Register Area Analysis	The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social and Family Af- fairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not corre- spond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not nec- essarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.
NUTS2 and NUTS3 regions	The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. <i>See below.</i>
