Increase of 2,900 in seasonally adjusted Live Register in July

The Live Register increased by 8,549 (+5.1%) persons in July to 177,501. This compares with a corresponding increase of 7,595 (+4.3%) in July of last year. When seasonal factors are taken into account the seasonally adjusted total increased from 166,400 in June to 169,300 this month, an increase of 2,900. See table 2a and graph opposite.

In the year to July 2004 there was a decrease of 7,946 (-4.3%). This compares to an annual decrease of 8,900 (-5.0%) recorded in the year to June 2004.

Other features include:


- The monthly increase of 8,549 comprised increases of 7,061 females and 1,488 males. See table 1a.
- The monthly increase in the Seasonally Adjusted series of 2,900 comprised an increase of 3000 females and a decrease of 100 males. See
- ♦ The standardised unemployment rate in July was 4.4%. This compares with 4.4% in January 2004, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. See table 3 and background notes.
- In the month the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 8,496 males and 12,795 females. See background notes.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest seasonally adjusted figure, for December to February 2004 is 85,500 persons unemployed.

Monthly increase in all regions

The monthly increase of 8,549 persons on the Live Register reflected increases in all regions. The largest monthly increases were in the Mid-East (+7.7%) and Midland (+7.4%) regions, while the lowest increases occurred in the Dublin (+3.6%) and Mid-West (+4.3%) regions.

Other area features in the month include:

- ♦ The number of males increased in all regions. The largest percentage increase was in the Midland region (+4.4%), while the lowest percentage increase was in the Dublin region (+0.1%).
- The number of females increased in all regions. The largest percentage increase was in the Mid East (+13.7%), while the lowest percentage increases were in the Border, Dublin and Mid-West regions (+9.1% each).
- There were increases in all counties. The largest percentage increases were in Roscommon (+9.1%), Meath (+8.5%) and Longford (8.5%), while the lowest increases occurred in North Tipperary (1.8%), Kerry (+2.4%) and Donegal (+3.2%). See tables 4 and 6.

A total of 27,415 persons joined the Live Register in July 2004. With 18,866 persons leaving the Register there is a net increase of 8,549 persons in the month.

Other features of the flows on and off the Register include:

- ♦ The average weekly increase of 1,710 in the Live Register was comprised of 1,412 females and 298 males. See tables 8 and 9.
- In the month there were weekly averages of 5,483 new claimants joining the Register and 3,773 persons leaving. See table 8.

Central Statistics Office Live Register Analysis

Background Notes

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social and Family Affairs. It comprises persons under 65 years **Live Register** of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute.

Descriptive

The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

statistics

Unemployment The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

Standardised unemployment

The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for January, April, July and October of each year are calculated using seasonally adjusted data from the Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register is then used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (adjusted for seasonality) are:

adjustment

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Bureau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

Casual and part-time workers

The casual and part-time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.

Flow Analysis

History of The flow analysis of the Live Register had been published monthly as a separate release since January 1989. Similar details were previously included in the Industrial Analysis of the Live Register, which was discontinued.

Flow Analysis

Live Register Changes in the level of flows on and off the Live Register in any month reflect conditions in the labour market and aspects of the social insurance system such as transfers to or from other welfare schemes, exhaustion of Unemployment Benefit (UB) entitlement without qualifying for Unemployment Assistance (UA) etc.

Tables 7, 8 & 9 to be removed

From next month, Tables 7-9 will be removed from the Live Register publication. These tables will be replaced with a new table that will provide summary data on average weekly changes to the Live Register in the month.

This change to the publication is for operational reasons and will help to ensure the continued timeliness of the Live Register publication. While this data will no longer be included in the published release, users can obtain updated copies of these tables on request from this office.

New registrations

The aggregate of new registrations for each Friday in a given month is used in conjunction with the net change over the same period to calculate the outflow from the register. A new registration is defined as anybody on the Live Register on a particular Friday who was not on it on the previous Friday.

Live Register Area Analysis

The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social and Family Affairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not correspond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not necessarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.

NUTS2 and The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial **NUTS3 regions** Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. See next page.
