Decrease of 2,800 in seasonally adjusted Live Register in September

The Live Register decreased by 15,350 (-8.7%) persons in September to 160,466. This compares with a corresponding decrease of 15,131 (-8.1%) in September of last year. When seasonal factors are taken into account the seasonally adjusted total decreased from 166,500 in August to 163,700 this month, a decrease of 2,800. *See table 2a and graph opposite*.

In the year to September 2004 there was a decrease of 10,356 (-6.1%). This compares to an annual decrease of 10,137 (-5.5%) recorded in the year to August 2004.

Other features include:

- ◆ The monthly decrease of 15,350 comprised decreases of 10,763 females and 4,587 males. *See table 1a.*
- ♦ The monthly decrease in the Seasonally Adjusted series of 2,800 comprised decreases of 800 males and 2,100 females. See table 2a.
- ♦ The standardised unemployment rate in September was 4.5%. This compares with 4.6% in April 2004, based on the Quarterly National Household Survey. *See table 3 and background notes*.
- ◆ In the month, the estimated number of casual and part-time workers on the Live Register was 8,039 males and 12,713 females. *See background notes*.

The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time workers (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National Household Survey and the latest seasonally adjusted figure, for March to May 2004, is 88,600 persons unemployed.

Monthly decreases in all regions

The monthly decrease of 15,350 persons on the Live Register reflected decreases in all regions. The largest monthly decreases were in the West (-10.2%) and Mid-West (-10.1%) regions, while the lowest decreases occurred in the South-West (-7.2%) and Dublin (-7.5%) regions.

Other features in the month include:

- ♦ The number of males decreased in all regions. The largest percentage decreases were in the Border (-5.9%), West and Mid-East (both -5.7%) regions, while the lowest decreases were in the Dublin (-3.7%) and South-West (-3.9%) regions.
- ♦ The number of females decreased in all regions. The largest percentage decreases were in the West (-15.6%) and Mid-West (-15.5%) regions, while the lowest decreases were in the South-West (-11.2%) and Dublin (-13.0%) regions.
- ◆ There were decreases in all counties. The largest percentage decreases were in Roscommon (-14.3%) and Monaghan (-12.4%), while the lowest decreases were in Wexford (-5.9%) and Kerry (-6.6%). See tables 4 and 6.

Central Statistics Office Live Register Analysis

Background Notes

Source and The Live Register is compiled from returns made directly to the Central Statistics Office by each scope of the local office of the Department of Social and Family Affairs. It comprises persons under 65 years **Live Register** of age in the following classes:

- All Claimants for Unemployment Benefit (UB) excluding systematic short-time workers
- Applicants for Unemployment Assistance (UA) excluding smallholders/farm assists and other self-employed persons
- Other registrants including applicants for credited Social Welfare contributions but excluding those directly involved in an industrial dispute.

Descriptive

The compilation basis for the Live Register statistics from May 1992 onwards is described in the September 1992 issue of the Statistical Bulletin. The March 1980 issue contained a description of the basis used up to April 1992 while a more comprehensive treatment of Live Register statistics appeared in the "Report of the Inter-Departmental Study Group on Unemployment Statistics" (Stationery Office Dublin, Prl. 7925, April 1979). The results of a special study of the differences between the Labour Force Survey (LFS) Estimates of Unemployment and the Live Register are contained in the December 1996 issue of the Statistical Bulletin.

statistics

Unemployment The Live Register is not designed to measure unemployment. It includes part-time (those who work up to three days a week), seasonal and casual workers entitled to Unemployment Assistance or Unemployment Benefit. Unemployment is measured by the Quarterly National House**hold Survey** (formerly the Annual Labour Force Survey).

Standardised unemployment

The Standardised Unemployment Rate (SUR) series in Table 3 is based on the estimated number of persons unemployed expressed as a percentage of the total economically active population (i.e. the Labour Force), using internationally comparable definitions of employment and unemployment, as recommended by the International Labour Office. Benchmark estimates of the SUR for January, April, July and October of each year are calculated using seasonally adjusted data from the Quarterly National Household Survey. The monthly trend in the seasonally adjusted Live Register is then used to estimate the monthly SUR between successive surveys.

This approach was temporarily suspended following the rapid decline in the Live Register after September 1996. A linear interpolation estimation approach was used between April 1996 and April 1997, as the Live Register series could not be used as an indicator of monthly trends in unemployment during that period. The traditional estimation approach has been used from April 1997 onwards.

QNHS The Quarterly National Household Survey, which began in September 1997, has now replaced the Labour Force Survey and provides quarterly estimates of the unemployment rate. The estimates (adjusted for seasonality) are:

adjustment

Seasonal The seasonal adjustment of the Live Register is completed using the X-11 Variant of the US Bureau of Census Method 2 (Additive Option). The seasonally adjusted series are updated twice yearly, in January and July; pending the next updating, seasonal adjustment for intervening months is carried out using projected seasonal factors. In Tables 2a, b and c, the seasonally adjusted totals are the sum of the relevant seasonally adjusted series for males and females, under and over 25 years.

part-time workers

Casual and The casual and part-time workers' figure is based on an estimate supplied by the Department of Social and Family Affairs. People may apply for Unemployment Benefit / Assistance if they only work for part of a week and be included on the Live Register.

Area Analysis

Live Register The basis of the area classification used in this release is the Department of Social and Family Affairs local office of registration. The areas served by Local Employment Offices do not correspond to specific geographic boundries. Therefore, registrants at a given local office do not necessarily come from a particular region or area which can be precisely delineated. A classification by area of residence of persons on the Live Register was published until January 1989 but was then discontinued.

NUTS3 regions

NUTS2 and The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 re-
