### December 2001

#### Inflation rises to 4.2% in December

This release provides a summary analysis of the major price developments within the main CPI commodity groups together with constituent CPI Sub-Indices and details of their monthly and annual percentage changes. It also details the annual and monthly percentage changes for each commodity group for each month from January 1999 to date.

A detailed description of the CPI is published in the June 1997 issue of the Irish Statistical Bulletin. This release, together with the monthly CPI Statistical Release is available on the CSO Web Site (<u>www.cso.ie</u>) immediately following publication.

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
## **Consumer Price Index**

## December 2001



### Food


Food prices rose by 0.6% in December but the annual rate of food inflation fell to 6.5% down from the 6.6% increase recorded in November. This compares with an annual increase of 5.1% in the year to December 2000. In December there were increases in the price of beef, lamb, pork, bacon, bread, fresh fruit and vegetables, dairy products, breakfast cereals and meals out. Reductions were recorded in the price of poultry, potatoes and soft drinks.





## **Alcoholic Drink**


Alcoholic Drink prices rose by 0.3% in December with increases in the prices of beer, spirits and wine purchased in public houses and hotels. The annual percentage change increased to 5.7%, up from 5.4% in November. The annual increase added 0.73% to the overall annual consumer price increase of 4.2%.





### **Tobacco**


Tobacco prices rose by 2.0% in December due to the higher rates of excise duty announced in the recent Budget. The annual percentage change since December 2000 was 4.3%.





## **Clothing & Footwear**


Clothing & Footwear prices decreased by 0.1% in December with decreases being recorded mainly in the price of ladies and mens outerwear, most childrenswear and footwear. Year on year Clothing & Footwear prices are now 3.0% lower than this time last year reflecting the continuing competition in this sector.



## **Fuel & Light**




Fuel & Light prices increased by 0.7% in December due mainly to an increase in the cost of electricity. This increase was sanctioned from 1 October but only began to impact on domestic household electricity bills from the beginning of December. The full effect of the increase will not be reflected until the January CPI. Home heating oil prices fell by 5.4% in December. The annual percentage decrease in Fuel & Light in the twelve months since December 2000 is 2.9%, down from the 3.7% decrease recorded in November. The annual decrease in the price of home heating oil in the year to December was 27.6%.



## Housing




Overall housing costs decreased by 1.7% in December reflecting further effects of recent European Central Bank interest rate cuts. House insurance costs rose by 4.5%. The annual increase in housing is now running at 0.7% down from 3.3% in November. Average mortgage payments have fallen by 11.2% in the year to December but house insurance premiums have increased by 21.2% in the same period.



## **Durable Household Goods**


Overall prices of Durable Household Goods increased by 0.6% in December due to increases in the price of many items of furniture, floor coverings and soft furnishings. The annual percentage change in the year to December is 1.3%, slightly higher than the increase of 1.2% recorded in November.



#### Other Goods




The price of Other Goods increased by 0.2% in December. The annual percentage change in the year to December is 4.4%, down from the 4.7% increase recorded in November. Price increases were recorded for magazines, newspapers, cleaning materials, cosmetics and personal hygiene products while price reductions were recorded for toys and toilet paper.



## **Transport**




Transport costs increased by 1.1% in December due mainly to excise duty increases in the price of motor fuel. Year on year overall transport costs are 1.4% higher. Motor fuel prices are now 10.2% lower than this time last year. Motor insurance costs decreased by 1.4% in December reducing the annual increase in motor insurance premiums to 18.7%. There were also increases in the cost of taxi fares, car hire and parking fees.



## Services & Related Expenditure




Services & Related Expenditure costs increased by 1.0% in December increasing the annual percentage change to 8.3%. This is higher than the 7.4% change recorded in November. There were increased charges for medical fees, entertainment, hairdressing, education and training, laundry and drycleaning, public telephones, trade union subscriptions, video hire and package holidays while the cost of accommodation fell.



## **Overall CPI**



Consumer Prices increased by 0.5% in December to bring the overall CPI to 118.2. This is higher than the 0.1% increase which was recorded in December 2000. As a result annual inflation in the twelve months to December 2001 rose to 4.2%.
