Annual inflation falls to 4.4% in June

This release provides a summary analysis of the major price developments within the main CPI COICOP groups together with constituent CPI Subgroups and details of their monthly percentage changes. It also details changes for each COICOP subgroup for each month from January 2000 to date.



Overall Consumer Price Index

Consumer Prices in June, as measured by the CPI, increased by 0.2% in the month. This was lower than the monthly increase of 0.5% in June of last year and, as a result, annual inflation fell to 4.4% compared to 4.7% in May.

The most significant monthly price changes were increases in Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels (+0.8%), Food & Non Alcoholic Beverages (+0.3%), Recreation & Culture (+0.3%) and Restaurants, Hotels & Licensed Premises (+0.3%). Price reductions were recorded for Communications (-0.5%) and Miscellaneous Goods and Services (-0.3%).

The most notable changes in the year were increases in Miscellaneous Good & Services (+10.4%), Health (+10.2%), Education (+9.7%), Restaurants, Hotels & Licensed Premises (+7.3%), Recreation & Culture (+7.0%) and Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco (+5.4%). Clothing & Footwear fell by 2.7%.




Overall Consumer Price Index

01 Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages

Food and Non Alcoholic Beverage prices increased by 0.3% in June, resulting in an annual increase of 2.7% in the year. This represents a decrease in the annual rate of inflation since May when the annual rate was 3.3%.

Food prices increased by 0.3% in the month while Non Alcoholic Beverages increased by 0.4% giving an overall increase of 0.3%. Since May prices rose for fresh fruit (+3.8%), lamb (+2.3%), biscuits (+1.9%), soup (+1.2%), tea (+1.0%), fresh fish (+1.0%), and sweets & chocolate (+0.9%). Price reductions were recorded for pork (-3.9%), eggs (-0.9%), cheese (-0.7%) and other meat products (-0.5%).



02 Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco

This category covers Alcoholic Beverages (purchased in an off-licence or supermarket) and Tobacco. Overall prices remained static in the month and increased by 5.4% in the year to June 2002. This compares with annual increases of 5.5% in the year to May 2002 and 2.1% in the period to June 2001.

Alcoholic Beverage prices were unchanged in the month while Tobacco prices rose by 0.1%.



03 Clothing and Footwear

Clothing & Footwear prices decreased by 0.2% in the month. Clothing prices decreased by 0.2% while Footwear increased by 0.1%. As a result of the continuing strong competition in this sector, average prices of clothing and footwear have decreased by 2.7% in the year since June 2001.

This category now also covers Clothing & Footwear services such as dry cleaning. The services element for both clothing and footwear increased by +0.4%.



04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels

This group covers the former categories of Housing (excluding insurance) and Fuel and Light combined into one overall category. Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels costs rose by 0.8% in June, resulting in an annual increase of 0.3%. This compares with an annual increase of 13.9% for June 2001, when the effects of higher crude oil prices and increased average mortgage payments resulted in significant annual increases. Over the course of 2001 this rate declined steadily.

In June increases were recorded in services for the maintenance and repair of the dwelling (+4.4%), mortgage interest (+1.0%) and rental costs (+0.8%). A decrease was recorded for home heating oil (-1.0%).



05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance costs increased by 0.2% in June. Price increases were recorded for non-durable household goods (+0.8%) and household textiles (+0.5%). The annual rate of increase in the year to June 2002 was 2.2%, marginally down on the year to May (+2.3%).

Annual % change




05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

06 Health

Health costs and charges increased by 0.1% in June putting the annual increase at 10.2%, the same as in the year to May. This compares with an annual rate of 7.7% for June 2001.

In June the most significant increase was recorded for medical products (+0.8%).


Annual % change

07 Transport


Transport costs remain unchanged in the month. The annual rate of increase in the year to June 2002 was 0.7%. Price increases were recorded in the cost of sea transport (+10.5%), other vehicle costs (+0.9%) and the maintenance and repair of vehicles (+0.8%). Price decreases were recorded for air transport (-1.7%) and motor fuels (-0.7%).


Following a decrease in the cost of telephone and telecommunication services, communication costs decreased by 0.5% in June putting the annual rate of increase at 3.2%. This compares with an annual rate of -10.1% for June 2001.

09 Recreation and Culture

Recreation and Culture covers the category of items of goods and services used for recreation and culture. It includes items such as nightclubs, televisions, newspapers and gardening. Prices rose by 0.3% in June, putting the annual increase for the year at 7.0%. Price increases were recorded for equipment for sport, camping and open-air recreation (+1.2%), pets and related products (+1.0%), veterinary and other services for pets (+0.9%), package holidays (+0.7%), gardens, plants & flowers (+0.5%) and newspapers & periodicals (+0.5%). Price decreases were recorded for information processing equipment (-0.6%), games, toys & hobbies (-0.2%) and nightclubs (-0.2%).


Education costs remain static in June while an annual increase of 9.7% was recorded, the same as that recorded for the year to May.

11 Restaurants and Hotels


The category covers three main areas (1) meals out (2) alcohol consumed in or on licensed premises and (3) accommodation services. Prices for the overall category rose by 0.3% in the month and by 7.3% in the year to June. The increase in the month was made up of a rise for accommodation services (+0.7%), soft drinks & mineral water (+0.4%), restaurants, cafes & fast food (+0.3%) and wine & cider (+0.3%).

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous Goods and Services covers a wide range of items from personal hygiene products, hairdressing, insurance, childcare, social protection, financial services to personal goods and other services. Overall prices decreased by 0.3% in the month, resulting in an annual increase to 10.4% for the year. Price increases were recorded for hair products (+1.7%), health & beauty treatments (+1.6%) and jewellery, clocks & watches (+0.5). Decreases were recorded for motor car insurance (-1.8%) and financial services (-0.3%)...
