Annual Inflation remains at 4.5% in September

This release provides a summary analysis of the major price developments within the main CPI COICOP groups together with constituent CPI Subgroups and details of their monthly percentage changes. It also details changes for each COICOP subgroup for each month from January 2000 to date.

A detailed description of the CPI is published in the Introduction of Updated Series, December 2001 =100. This release, together with the monthly CPI Statistical Release is available on the CSO Web Site (www.cso.ie) immediately following publication.

Tables using the old national classification are also included for analysis.



Overall Consumer Price Index

Consumer Prices in September, as measured by the CPI, increased by 0.5% in the month. This was marginally higher than the monthly increase for September of last year but the annual rate of inflation remains at 4.5%.

The most significant monthly price changes were increases in Miscellaneous Good & Services (+2.7%), Clothing & Footwear (+2.4%), Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels (+0.6%) and Recreation & Culture (+0.3%).

The most notable changes in the year were increases in Miscellaneous Goods & Services (+11.2%), Health (+10.0%), Education (+9.7%), Restaurants, Hotels & Licenced Premises (+7.3%), Recreation & Culture (+5.5%) and Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco (+5.4%). Clothing & Footwear fell by 5.4%.




Overall Consumer Price Index

01 Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages

Food and Non Alcoholic Beverage prices increased by 0.1% in September, resulting in an annual increase of 2.6% in the year. The annual increase is the same as that recorded for the year to August (+2.6%).

Food prices and Non Alcoholic Beverages prices both increased by 0.1% in the month. Since August prices rose for processed meat products (+1.3%), pork (+1.3%), lamb (+1.2%), preserves (+1.2%), cakes (+1.0%), potatoes (+1.0%), poultry (+0.9%), other fruits (+0.8%) and soft drinks & mineral water (+0.8%). Price reductions were recorded for cheese (-1.6%), fruit juices (-1.4%), beef (-1.2%), fresh fish (-1.2%), fresh vegetables (-1.0%) and bacon (-0.6%).



02 Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco

This category covers Alcoholic Beverages (purchased in an off-licence or supermarket) and Tobacco products. Prices remained static in the month and increased by 5.4% in the year to September 2002, marginally down on the year to August when the annual rate was 5.5%. This compares with an annual rate of 2.2% for September 2001.

Alcoholic Beverages prices decreased by 0.1% in the month while Tobacco prices remained unchanged. The price changes in Alcohol were an increase in spirits (+0.1%) and a decrease in beer (-0.1%).



03 Clothing and Footwear

Clothing & Footwear prices increased by 2.4% in the month. Clothing prices increased by 2.5% and Footwear increased by 1.7%. As a result of the continuing strong competition in this sector, average prices of clothing and footwear have decreased by 5.4% in the year since September 2001.

This category now also covers Clothing & Footwear services such as dry cleaning. The service element for clothing increased by 1.1% and footwear increased by 0.9%.



04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels

This group covers the former categories of Housing (excluding insurance) and Fuel and Light combined into one overall category. Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels costs rose by 0.6% in the month, while the annual rate increased by 0.6% in the year to September. This compares with an annual increase of 8.4% for September 2001, when the effects of higher crude oil prices and increased average mortgage payments resulted in significant annual increases. Over the course of 2001 this rate declined steadily.

In September increases were recorded for home heating oil (+2.1%), materials for house maintenance and repair (+1.2%) and mortgage interest (+1.0%).



05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance costs increased by 0.2% in the month and by 1.6% in the year to September 2002, the same as in the year to August.

Price increases were recorded for glassware, tableware & household utensils (+0.9%), small tools and miscellaneous accessories (+0.5%), furniture, furnishings, carpets & other flooring (+0.4%) and domestic & household services (+0.3%). Price reductions were recorded for major tools & equipment (-0.4%) and non-durable household goods (-0.3%).



06 Health

Health costs and charges increased by 0.1% in September putting the annual increase at 10.0%, marginally down from 10.1% in the year to August. This compares with an annual rate of 7.3% for September 2001.


In September the most significant increase was recorded for therapeutic appliances & equipment (+0.6%). Therapeutic appliances & equipment prices are collected annually in September.

07 Transport


Transport costs remained static in the month. The annual rate of increase in the year to September 2002 was 4.3%. Price increases were recorded for rail transport (+6.4%), petrol (+0.2%) and bus fares (+0.2%). Price decreases were recorded for sea transport (-17.1%), other vehicle costs (-4.3%), air transport (-1.2%) and diesel (-0.3%). A reduction in car rental charges was the main contributor to the 'other vehicle costs' decrease.

08 Communications


There was no change in telephone & telecommunication services and postal service costs in September. Communication costs increased by 1.7% for the year to September 2002. This compares with an annual rate of -8.9% for September 2001.

09 Recreation and Culture


Recreation and Culture covers the category of items of goods and services used for recreation and culture. It includes items such as nightclubs, televisions, newspapers and gardening. Prices rose by 0.3% in September, putting the annual increase for the year at 5.5%. Price increases were recorded for veterinary and other services for pets (+2.5%), books (+2.4%), package holidays (+0.9%), video film hire (+0.8%), cinema (+0.7%), pets & related products (+0.6%) and recording media (+0.6%). Price decreases were recorded for information processing equipment (-0.5%), newspapers & periodicals (-0.5%) and equipment for the reception, recording & reproduction of sound and pictures (-0.5%).

10 Education

Education costs remained static in September, while an annual increase of 9.7% was recorded. This is the same as that recorded for the year to August (+9.7%). This compares with an annual rate of 7.0% for September 2001.



11 Restaurants and Hotels

The category covers three main areas (1) meals out (2) alcohol consumed in or on licensed premises and (3) accommodation services. Prices for the overall category rose by 0.1% in the month and by 7.3% in the year to September.

The marginal change in the month was made up of increases in restaurants, cafes & fast food (+0.4%), soft drinks & mineral water (+0.4%), spirits (+0.3%), wine & cider (+0.3%) and beer (+0.2%); partially offset by a decrease in accommodation services (-0.8%).



12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous Goods and Services covers a wide range of items from personal hygiene products, hairdressing, insurance, childcare, social protection, financial services to personal goods and other services. Overall prices increased by 2.7% in the month, resulting in an annual increase of 11.2% for the year to September 2002. This represents an increase since August when the annual rate of inflation was 9.8%.

The most significant increase in the sector was a 15.9% rise in health insurance costs. Price increases were also recorded for health & beauty treatments (+5.2%) and other personal grooming (+1.7%). A decrease was recorded in the cost of hair products (-1.0%).
