Consumer Prices Bi-annual Average Price Analysis Dublin and Outside Dublin May 2006

This release presents an update of the bi-annual price level comparison for Dublin and outside Dublin as last published in November 2005. The current data are published from prices collected for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) in May 2006.

As was the case previously, it is possible to construct comparable average prices for the two regions (Dublin and outside Dublin) for 73 goods and services from CPI data. This accounts for approximately 24.5% of the total value of the CPI basket of goods and services.

Tables 1 and 2 present the average price data for the two regions, while Table 3 gives a price level comparison. Table 4 presents historical data for May 2005 and November 2005.

Comment

It should be noted that the prices of goods and services are determined by factors such as outlet location & size, brand and quality. This should be borne in mind when considering the information contained in the tables below.

Of the 73 items included, average prices were higher in Dublin for 40 and lower for 33. (See Table 3 and Summary Table on next page).

Between Dublin and outside Dublin, 24 items had average prices that fell within a 3% range of each other. Average prices for another 30 items were more than 3% higher in Dublin, while the remaining 19 were more than 3% lower.

Meat, Fish and Fruit & Vegetables prices generally higher in Dublin

As of May 2006, 11 of the 18 meat items were showing higher prices in Dublin. The differences ranged from 17.6% higher for best back rashers to 10.4% lower for a fillet/half leg of pork. (See Table 3). In November 2005, eight of the meat items had shown higher prices in Dublin.

Higher average prices were shown in Dublin for four of the five fish products included in the analysis. The differences ranged from 12.1% higher for salmon steak to 2.0% lower for fillets of whiting. (See Table 3).

It was more expensive in Dublin for five of the nine fruit and vegetable items included in the analysis. The differences ranged from 7.2% more expensive for mushrooms to 9.2% cheaper for bananas (See Table 3).

Other Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages prices generally lower in Dublin

For the remaining Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages products (including milk, cheese, butter, eggs, bread, flour, sugar, tea, spaghetti, preserves and orange juice), 14 of the items showed lower average prices in Dublin, ranging from 1.6% lower for brown wholemeal flour to 17.5% lower for spaghetti. The three exceptions to this were standard eggs (5.7% higher), large eggs (5.6% higher) and orange juice (5.1% higher). (See Table 3).

Drinks out For Alcoholic Beverages, as before, the comparison varied greatly between take home drink and drinks consumed on a licensed premises. For take home drink, average prices were generally comparable with 3% or less difference between Dublin and outside Dublin, for all but three items. These items were bottle of brandy (4.0% lower in Dublin), cider (3.2% lower in Dublin) and bottle of whiskey (3.3% higher in Dublin). (See Table 3).

> For alcohol consumed on a licensed premises, average prices were consistently higher in Dublin with all but one of the items showing average prices more than 5% higher than outside Dublin. The greatest difference was for a half-pint of lager where average prices in Dublin were 13.9% higher. (See Table 3).

Tobacco prices slightly higher in Dublin

For Tobacco, there was a minor difference with average prices in Dublin 0.6% higher. (See Table 3).

Petrol prices slightly lower in Dublin

Average unleaded petrol prices were 0.9% lower in Dublin while average diesel prices were 0.5% lower in Dublin. (See Table 3).

Average prices can only be compared for two services namely cinema entrance (19.0% higher in Dublin) and ladies wash, cut & blow dry (17.5% higher in Dublin), (See Table 3).

Prices On average, prices were 3.5% higher in Dublin for the items included in this analysis. This compares to 3.1% in November 2005 and 3.2% in May 2005. When drinks out are excluded from the comparison, the difference falls to an average of 0.3% higher in Dublin (as compared to 0.2% in November 2005 and 0.3% in May 2005). (See Tables 3 & 4).

Lower variation in prices in Dublin Typically in Dublin there were smaller differences between the average of the 5 lowest quotes and the 5 highest quotes for the items priced. On average, the highest 5 quotes were 79.7% higher than the corresponding lowest 5 quotes, whereas outside Dublin the difference was, on average, 115.3%. (See Tables 1 & 2).
