

Output price index up 9.8% in 2007

Preliminary estimates of the agricultural price indices for 2007 show a 9.8% increase in output prices from 2006 levels while input prices increased by 5.4% (see graph). The terms of trade index increased by 4.2% indicating a favourable price movement for farmers in the year.

The increase in the output index of 9.8% was due mainly to increases in the prices of cereals (67.6%), milk (23.4%) and vegetables (11.5%). See Table 1.

Comparing the annual 2007 input indices with the annual 2006 indices shows that (see Table 2):

- ♦ Feeding stuffs increased by 10.2%.
- ♦ Seeds, veterinary expenses and energy increased by 8.9%, 3.0% and 2.9% respectively.
- ◆ Fertilizers increased by 1.8%.

Diagram 1 : Changes in selected agricultural outputs, 2006/2007




Diagram 2 : Changes in selected agricultural inputs, 2006/2007



Background Notes

Introduction

This release presents preliminary estimates of agricultural price indices. The indices monitor trends in prices paid to farmers for their produce and in prices paid by farmers for purchases of goods and services.

The estimates are given to Eurostat, the Statistical Office of the European Communities, who provide the Directorate-General for Agriculture in Brussels with forecasts of the annual EU agricultural price indices for the current year.

Methodology

The preliminary annual indices are compiled by using the published monthly indices from January to August and forecast estimates for September to December. Preliminary annual indices are obtained either as a simple or weighted arithmetic mean of the corresponding monthly indices. The monthly sub-indices are weighted by the value of sales off farms and the expenditure on farm inputs to derive overall monthly total input and total output indices. From 1995, in line with EU recommendations, the annual input indices are calculated as simple arithmetic averages of the monthly averages.

Data Sources

The indices are compiled from a wide variety of sources, including direct CSO surveys and administrative data from the Department of Agriculture and Food.
