Earnings

- Average annual earnings were €37,726 (including annual bonuses and benefit-in-kind) in 2007 across all sectors of the economy, an increase of 1.4% from 2006. Annual bonuses and benefit-in-kind were €2,120 in 2007 compared with €2,046 in 2006.
- Female average annual earnings were 72.9% of male earnings, with females earning on average €31,403 as against €43,099 for males in 2007.
- Average weekly earnings increased in 2008 by 1.2% in the construction sector, 2.7% in distribution and business services and by 2.9% in the public sector.
- Total labour costs were €50,880 per employee in industry in 2008 and €70,910 per employee in the financial sector.

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Introduction

This chapter contains information on average weekly earnings of employees in various economic sectors (industry; agriculture; construction; the banking, insurance and building societies sector; the distribution and business services sector and the public sector). In some cases further information (eg breakdown by sub-sector or by gender) is shown. The data are derived mostly from CSO quarterly inquiries as well as an annual survey.

National Employment Survey

Overall, average annual earnings were €37,726 in 2007, an increase of 1.4% over the previous year. Bonuses and benefit in kind (BiK) account for €2,120 of annual earnings, up from €2,046 in 2006. Electricity, gas and water supply had the highest average earnings of €71,572 while the lowest were in Hotels and restaurants sector at €23,505. Earnings were €54,213 in the Financial intermediation sector and this sector also had the highest bonuses and BiK at €8,345. Such bonuses were smallest in the Hotels and restaurants sector at €287 per person.

Managers and administrators earned the most of any occupational group, at €61,690 while those in Sales and Other (mainly unskilled workers) both had around €26,500 each (€26,523 and €26,560 respectively). While Managers and administrators had average annual bonuses and BiK of €6,416, those in the Others occupational category received €692 per person.

Earnings tend to increase with age and peak in the 40s and 50s. While those under 25 years of age earned €22,840, those aged between 40 and 60 earned just over €42,000. Earnings then declined for those aged 60 or over, with annual average earnings of €36,701. Those employees with a third level degree or better earned €51,077 in 2007, while those with a primary or lower secondary level of education earned on average €30,814.

Earnings also tended to increase with length of time working. While those with less than 5 years work experience earned €24,871, those with 30 or more years earned on average €47,894. Women earned €31,403 compared to €43,099 for men in 2007 (or 72.9% of male earnings). Those in the public sector earned €46,349 on average, compared with €35,206 in the private sector, a difference of 31.7%.

Short-term earnings

Average weekly earnings in the construction sector rose from €811.38 in 2007 to €821.50 in 2008, an increase of 1.2%. However, while hourly earnings rose by 3% from €18.48 to €19.03, average hours worked dropped from 43.9 hours per week in 2007 to 43.2 hours in 2008, a fall of 1.6%.

In the public sector (excluding health) earnings per week rose by 2.9% from 2007 to 2008, from €922.46 per week to €948.91. Weekly earnings rose from €716.04 to €737.32 (a rise of 3%) in the distribution sector over the same period while earnings rose by 2.6% or from €705.34 per week to €723.62 in the business services sector.

The EHECS (Earnings, Hours and Employment Costs Survey) is a new survey that collects data on employment, wages and salaries, hours and other labour costs. The EHECS replaces the Quarterly Industrial Inquiry (QII) and the Banking, Insurance and Building Societies (BIBS) survey. Using methodology as broadly similar as possible to the QII and BIBS, average weekly earnings for industrial workers in Industry increased from €635.11 in Q4 2007 to €648.76 in Q4 2008, a rise of 2.1%. Average weekly earnings for all employees in the industrial sector rose by 3.8%, from €757.66 in Q4 2007 to €786.65 in Q4 2008. Earnings in the Financial Intermediation sector rose from €895.88 per week to €925.86, a rise of 3.3%.

Annual average wages and earnings for all employees in industry was €41,950 in 2008. This compared to €56,229 for the financial intermediation sector. Within industry, while average wages and salaries were €60,444 for the electricity, gas and water supply section, manufacturing had an average of €40,370. While managers, professional and associated professionals (technicians etc) earned €63,026 in industry in 2008, the comparable figure for production, transport, craft and other manual workers was €34,431.

Total annual labour costs per person were €50,880 in industry and €70,910 in the financial intermediation sector in 2008. While managers, professional and associated professionals had average labour costs of €78,303 in industry, the comparable figure in the financial intermediation sector was €98,959. Annual average labour costs for clerical, sales and service employees were roughly equivalent; €47,674 in industry and €43,416 in the financial sector.


