

Number of Trips to Ireland decreases by 3.5%

There were 822,800 Overseas Trips to Ireland in August 2004 compared with 852,500 in the same month last year, a decrease of 3.5%. In the year to date to the end of August 2004 there were 4,550,900 Overseas Trips to Ireland, an increase of 3.5% on the figure of 4,397,100 for the first 8 months of 2003.

The number of Trips to Ireland in August 2004 by Residents of Great Britain fell by 2.4% compared with the same month in 2003. In the year to date to the end of August the number is down 0.6% on the same period in 2003.

In August 2004, Trips to Ireland by Residents of Other European Countries fell by 4.5% to 215,100 on the corresponding August 2003 figure of 225,200.

Trips to Ireland by Residents of North America in August 2004 decreased by 3.3% when compared with August 2003. In the year to date to the end of August the number was up 8.2% on the first 8 months of 2003.

There were 33,500 Trips to Ireland by Residents of Other Areas in August 2004, a decrease of 4,200 on the same month in 2003.

Irish Residents made 594,700 Overseas Trips in August 2004, an increase of 5% on the figure of 566,600 in August 2003.

Background Notes

Periodicity Monthly. Overseas Travel. Scope Coverage All Overseas Travel into and out of Ireland. **Data Collection** Information is collected via interview at airports and seaports. Sample Design A sample of sailings and flights is selected and a systematic sample of passengers on each is surveyed. The selection of sailings and flights is done in such a way as to ensure proper representation of day and night sailings/flights and weekday and weekend sailings/flights. On the selected sailings/flights, a 1 in 5 systematic sample of passengers is selected and their country of residence is recorded. Sample results are grossed up to total passenger numbers provided by the airports and ferry companies. Sample Size The sample size in the August 2004 Country of Residence Survey was almost 74,000 passengers. Definitions Trips Eurostat methodology defines a Visitor as "any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than

his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited". However, as the Country of Residence Survey does not establish the reason for an individual's trip or length of stay, those travelling for reason of remuneration or for more than one year to this country cannot be excluded. Therefore for the purposes of this Survey "Trips" includes those travelling for remuneration in Ireland. Commercial Drivers travelling on sea routes are excluded.

Country of Residence

Country of Residence is defined as the country in which a person has resided during the past year.
