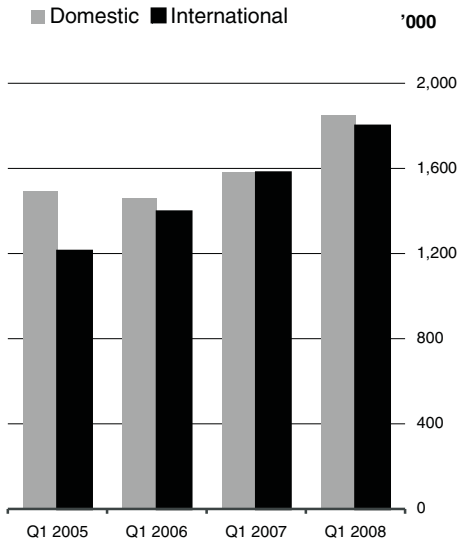

Slight fall in domestic travel expenditure for Q1 2008

Domestic Travel

- ◆ Irish residents spent a total of €284.2m on domestic trips in Q1 2008, down slightly from the €288.9m recorded in Q1 2007. Holiday expenditure grew by 8.5% to €181m from Q1 2007 but this was more than offset by reduced spending on business trips and those visiting friends and relatives. *See Table 7.*
- ◆ Total domestic trips by Irish residents increased by 17.2% to 1,851,000 in Q1 2008 from that recorded in Q1 2007. The greater growth in holiday trips (15.1%) and those visiting friends and relatives (23.4%) accounted for most of this increase. *See Table 2.*
- ◆ Nights spent on domestic travel grew by just over 16% to 4,626,000 from Q1 2007. The number of nights spent on holidays grew by just under 20% to 2,336,000, as did nights spent visiting friends and relatives increasing by 24.7% to 1,592,000. However the number of nights spent on business trips fell by 10.7% to 425,000. *See Table 2.*

International Travel

- ◆ Expenditure on international trips by Irish residents amounted to €1,594.5m in Q1 2008, which was up 17.1% on Q1 2007. Holiday expenditure increased by 21.4% to €1,132.2m while there were more modest increases in spending on business trips and those visiting friends and relatives. *See Table 15.*
- ◆ The number of international trips undertaken by Irish residents in Q1 2008 at 1,800,000 was up 13.9% on Q1 2007. Holiday trips abroad showed the strongest growth rising by 18.7% to 1,218,000 and this was accompanied by an increase of almost 25% to 8,821,000 in the number of holiday nights. The number of nights spent on visiting friends and relatives and business trips both grew but to a much lesser extent. *See Table 10.*
- ◆ In terms of regions visited, Asia & Middle East showed strong gains in Q1 2008 compared to the same quarter in 2007. The total number of trips increased by 71% to 53,000 while the number of nights increased by just over 47% to 784,000. Irish visitors spent a total of €134.9m in this region in Q1 2008, which was over twice that in Q1 2007. *See Tables 9 and 16.*

Note: In comparing Q1 2008 and Q1 2007, it should be noted that Easter occurred wholly in the first quarter of 2008 compared with 2007.

Background Notes

Reference Period	Calendar quarters.
Scope	Domestic and International travel patterns involving overnight stays of all residents of the Republic of Ireland.
Coverage	All private households.
Purpose	The purpose of the Household Travel Survey (HTS) is to measure domestic and international travel patterns involving overnight stays and associated details (expenditure, purpose of trip, type of accommodation used etc.) of Irish residents. The survey is one of several Central Statistics Office (CSO) tourism surveys conducted to comply with the requirements of Council Directive 95/57/EC of 23 November 1995 concerning the collection of statistical information in the field of tourism.
Data Collection	Information is collected via postal survey on a quarterly basis by the Central Statistics Office.
Sample Design	The HTS is a random stratified sample. Each quarter, almost 13,000 households (or approximately 1% of all private households) are randomly selected from the Electoral Register, where the selection is stratified by District Electoral Division.

A two stage weighting process is used. Firstly, survey results are weighted to agree with household population estimates broken down by *household type* (the number of persons 18 or over) and *region* (NUTS 3). The household population estimates are provided by the Quarterly National Household Survey (QNHS). Secondly, these results are further weighted to agree with the Tourism & Travel frontier results.

Regional and Age Group Data

While the overall aggregate estimates are robust, falling response rates and reduced coverage has resulted in detailed data at NUTS3 level for Q3 2007 becoming less reliable. Accordingly, it is necessary to publish such regional data at a more aggregated NUTS2 level. Similarly the number of age groups have been reduced. We are, however, satisfied with the overall quality of detailed estimates published up to Q2 2007.

NUTS Regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS 3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS 2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS 3 regions. The composition of the regions is set out below.

Definitions

Tourism The activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year for leisure, business or other purposes. Stays in prison, military service and hospital or clinics etc. are excluded. Trips taken for the purposes of work, where clearly distinguishable from business trips, should also be excluded.

*

From Quarter 4 2005, a number of changes were made to the Household Travel Survey questionnaire. One of these changes, to the Reason for Journey question, was to explicitly include "Work" in the "Business" category.

This change was made to address the Survey's inability to distinguish between business and work trips.

The effect of this change appears to have been a reduction in the trips in the "Other" category and an increase in the "Business" category.

Also changed was the Booking Method used for trips, Two options were removed that of 'Privately organised', and 'Package Tour or Holiday'. Introduced in their place were 'Internet Booking /Reservation' and 'Other form of Direct booking/Reservation' (e.g. by phone etc.). This has allowed us to subdivide the largest booking category formerly 'Privately Booked/No Pre-Booking' into 3 categories, 'Internet', 'Direct' and 'No Pre-booking'. Before Q4 2005 these categories are grouped together.

Domestic tourism is defined as the activities of residents of the Republic of Ireland travelling to and staying in places only within the Republic of Ireland but outside their usual environment.

International tourism is defined as the activities of residents of the Republic of Ireland travelling to and staying in places outside the Republic of Ireland and outside their usual environment.

National tourism is defined as *Domestic* tourism plus *International* tourism.

Overnight Visitor

An overnight visitor is a visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place, county or country visited. A visitor is defined as any person travelling to a place other than that of usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited (i.e. work). Consequently the following are excluded:

- Short-distance local transport and commuting i.e. more or less regular trips between place of work/study and place of residence.
- Routine or regular visits e.g. visiting parents every weekend.
- For visits of more than 12 consecutive months, a traveller will be considered a resident of that place (from a statistical standpoint).
- Migratory movements for work purposes.

The following are excluded from Domestic travel:

Residents travelling within the country with the intention of changing their usual residence.
Persons who travel to work temporarily in institutions within the country.
Persons who travel regularly or frequently between neighbouring localities to work or study.
Nomads and persons without fixed residence.
Armed forces on manoeuvre.

The following are excluded from International travel:

Persons leaving the country as migrants, including dependants accompanying or joining them.
 Persons, known as border workers, residing near the border in the Republic of Ireland but working in the North of Ireland.
 Diplomats, consular officers and members of the armed forces when travelling outside of the Republic of Ireland on assignment. This includes dependants and household employees accompanying or joining them.
 Persons travelling as refugees or nomads.

Tourism Expenditure

Total consumption expenditure is any expenditure made by a visitor or on behalf of a visitor for during their trip and stay at destination.

Tourism expenditure includes purchases of consumer goods and services inherent in travel and stay, purchases of small durable goods for personal use, souvenirs and gifts for family and friends.

The following outlays or acquisitions are excluded:

- Purchases for commercial purposes, for resale, purchases made on behalf of an employer during a business trip.
- Capital type investments or transactions engaged in by visitors, such as land, housing, real estate, works of art and other important acquisitions (such as cars, caravans, boats, second houses), even though they may be used in the future for tourism travel purposes.
- Cash given to relatives or friends during the trip, which does not represent payment of tourism goods or services, as well as donations made to institutions.
