

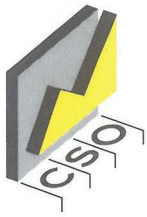

Commentary

Introduction

This report has been prepared by the Central Statistics Office for the Minister for Health and Children in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of the Vital Statistics and Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act, 1952.

Marriages

The number of marriages registered during the quarter was 2,168 equivalent to a rate of 2.3 per 1,000 population, the same as for the corresponding quarter of 2000.

Births

The number of births registered during the quarter was 14,785. Of these 7,671 were male and 7,114 were female. This represents a rate of 15.6 per 1,000 of the population, 0.7 above that for the corresponding quarter of 2000.

There were 4,877 births outside marriage, equivalent to 33 per cent of all births registered.

Deaths

There were 8,408 deaths registered during the quarter. Of these 4,290 were male and 4,118 female. The equivalent rate was 8.9 per 1,000 population, 1.6 below that for the corresponding quarter of 2000.

Deaths classified according to cause and age group are shown in Table 12, and by cause and area of residence in Table 13. The number of deaths registered in each area is shown in Table 10.

- **Diseases of the Circulatory System:**

Diseases of the Circulatory System accounted for 3,523 deaths, or an annual rate of 3.7 per 1,000 population. Of these 1,867 were due to Ischaemic Heart Disease and 730 to Cerebrovascular Disease.

- **Malignant Neoplasms:**

Deaths from all malignant neoplasms numbered 2,040. This is equivalent to an annual rate of 2.2 per 1,000 population. Of these 625 were due to malignant neoplasms of the digestive system and 419 to malignant neoplasms of the trachea, bronchus and lung.

- **Diseases of the Respiratory System:**

There were 731 deaths from pneumonia; bronchitis, emphysema and asthma (including chronic obstructive airways disease) accounted for 464 deaths; 244 deaths resulted from other respiratory diseases.

- **Injury and Poisoning:**

There were 62 deaths from injuries received in motor vehicle accidents (including non-traffic accidents) while all other injuries and poisonings accounted for 192 deaths.

- **Infant Mortality:**

There were 81 deaths of infants under one year of age. Of these 56 occurred at ages under 4 weeks. The infant mortality rate was 5.5 per 1,000 births registered and the neo-natal rate was 3.8. The rates for the corresponding quarter in 2000 were 6.1 and 4.2 respectively. The rates for counties are shown in Table 10.

Population

The estimated population in April 2000 was 3,786,900 persons.

Methodology

All figures in this report are classified by quarter of registration. Delay in the registration of some births, deaths and marriages result in them being included in a later period in these quarterly reports. Deaths are coded according to the 9th Revision of the International Statistical Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of Death.
