

Couples marrying later

The average age of grooms in 2002 was 32.5 years, compared with 30.2 years in 1996 and 28.6 years in 1990. The pattern for brides is similar with the average age increasing steadily from 26.6 years in 1990 to 30.4 years in 2002. See Table 1.

The number of marriages registered in 2002 was 20,556, which equates to a crude marriage rate of 5.2 per 1,000 of the population. This compares with a total of 16,174 and a marriage rate of 4.5 per thousand in 1996.

The number of civil marriages almost quadrupled from 928 in 1996 to 3,683 in 2002. This represents an increase from 5.7% of all marriages in 1996 to 17.9% in 2002. A contributing factor to this increase was the legalisation of divorce in 1997 and the consequential increase in the incidence of re-marriage. See Table 1.


The most popular month for marriage in 2002 was August, when 17% of marriages occurred. The least popular months were January and February, with just 3% of marriages occurring in each of these months. Saturday is the most popular day of the week to get married with almost 40% of marriages occurring on that day. The least popular day was Sunday when just 2% of marriages were recorded. See Table 16.

Data for the years 1997-2001 inclusive are not yet available due to difficulties associated with extraction of the relevant information from the marriage registration documentation.


Work on the marriage data for 2003 and 2004 is ongoing. Difficulties in the processing of data for these years are also being experienced due to the phased implementation of the electronic registration system.

Form of Ceremony, 1996 and 2002



Almost 60% of grooms aged over thirty on wedding day

In 2002 59.3% of grooms were aged thirty or over on their wedding day. This contrasts with 42.4% in 1996 and just 28% in 1990. The proportion of older brides has also increased, with 44.2% aged thirty or over in 2002 compared with 27.7% in 1996 and 16.2% in 1990. *See Table 1*.

The overall marriage rate for males aged 16 to 49, which had declined from 20.4 per thousand in 1991 to 17.7 in 1996, increased to 19.7 per 1,000 in 2002. However an examination of the age specific marriage rates shows vastly differing trends over the entire period for those in their twenties vis-à-vis those in their thirties. The marriage rate declined for each age from 20 to 28 inclusive between 1991 and 2002 while a small increase occurred for those aged 29 years. For each of the ages 30 to 49 inclusive there were significant increases in the male marriage rate in all cases.

The overall marriage rate for females aged 16 to 49 shows a similar pattern and increased from 17.8 marriages per 1,000 in 1996 to 20.2 marriages per 1,000 in 2002. The marriage rate for females decreased for each age from 20 to 26 inclusive between 1991 and 2002. For those aged 27 the rate increased between 1991 and 1996 but fell back to just below the 1991 rate in 2002. There were significant increases in the female marriage rate for each age from 28 to 49 inclusive. *See Table 2*.

In 2002 the groom was older than the bride in 63% of marriages, the same age in a further 12% of marriages and in the remaining 25% of cases the bride was older than the groom. *See Tables 7 and 8*.

The highest average age for grooms was in Dun Laoghaire Rathdown, with an average age of 34.8 years, with the lowest average age of 30.4 years in County Longford. The highest average age for brides was also in Dun Laoghaire Rathdown, with an average age of 32.4 years, while the lowest average age was 28.7 years in County Donegal. *See Tables 9 and 10*.

Catholic Church marriages fall as a proportion of all marriages

The number of Roman Catholic marriage ceremonies increased from 14,607 in 1996 to 15,908 in 2002. However, this increase masked a significant decline, from over 90% to 77%, in the proportion of all marriages accounted for by these ceremonies. The quadrupling in the number of Civil Marriages (with the proportion of the total increasing from under 6% to almost 18%) accounts for this decline in the Roman Catholic share.

The number of Church of Ireland ceremonies increased from 483 to 781, or from 3% of all marriages in 1996 to 3.8% of all marriages in 2002.

The number of marriages for other religious denominations that are licensed to register marriages¹ showed very little change over the five-year period from 1996 to 2002, increasing from 156 to 184. *See Table 1*.


Couples in Civil Marriages older than overall average

The average age of the groom in civil marriages was 36.4 years, almost 4 years higher than the overall average of 32.5. The average age of the bride in civil marriages was 33.4 years, 3 years higher than the overall average of 30.4. A contributing factor to this higher average age is re-marriage following divorce. However, specific data on this category is not yet available.

Over one-third of grooms (34.8%) and brides (35.5%) residing in Dublin City had civil marriages. On the other hand, less than one in twenty grooms (4.7%) and brides (4.5%) living in County Monaghan had civil marriages.

At regional level, 28.4% of grooms and 29% of brides living in the Dublin region had civil marriages. By contrast, only 10.5% of grooms and 9.8% of brides living in the Border region had civil marriages. *See Tables 14 and 15*.

Less couples living outside Ireland after marriage

Almost 90% of grooms and just over 91% of brides were living in Ireland before marriage. The future permanent residence of the married couple was stated to be outside Ireland in just over 11% of marriages, compared with 16% in 1996. *See Tables 1*, 9 and 10.

Over 88% of grooms residing in Donegal married brides residing in Donegal. On the other hand, less than 63% of Leitrim grooms married brides residing in Leitrim.

In relation to brides almost 85% of brides residing in Wexford married grooms residing in Wexford. At the other end of the scale, however, just 52% of Leitrim brides married grooms residing in Leitrim.

In almost 1,700 marriages the bride and groom were both resident outside the State. In a further 473 cases a non-resident groom married a bride resident in the State while just 159 non resident brides married grooms living here. *See Tables 11 and 12*.

Central Statistics Office Marriages

Background Notes

Source

These statistics have been compiled from the marriage registration forms of all marriages registered in the Republic of Ireland in 2002.

The release has been prepared by the Central Statistics Office for the Minister for Health and Children in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of the Vital Statistics and Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act, 1952.

Methodology

Where the weekday and month of a marriage are specified in this release, it refers to the date on which the marriage occurred. Note that some marriages registered in 2002 (and hence included in these statistics) occurred in years before 2002.

Form of Ceremony

Marriages celebrated according to the rites and ceremonies of the Roman Catholic Church, the rites and ceremonies of the Church of Ireland, the forms and disciplines of the Presbyterian Church, the usages of the Society of Friends, the usages of people professing the Jewish religion, and the usages of certain other Religious Bodies have been classified under their respective religions.

There is at present no provision for the civil registration of Muslim Marriage Ceremonies solemnised in the State.

Remarriage

The information required to identify divorced peoples remarriages was not extracted at the time of initial processing. However this issue will be addressed during the preparation of the marriage data relating to the years 1997 - 2004 inclusive.

Socio-Economic Group (SEG) This classification is determined by a person's occupation or, in some cases by a combination of occupation and employment status. The men and women whose marriages were registered in 2002 were classified by SEG on the basis of the information on occupation given in the marriage register.

Area of residence

Four classifications of district are available: that in which the marriage took place, the areas of residence of the bride and groom prior to marriage, and the intended future residence.

Age specific marriage rates

The age specific marriage rates are calculated as follows:

Age Specific Rate = Number of Males(or Females) of that age whose marriages were registered multiplied by 1,000 and divided by Population of Males (or Females) of that age. The small number of marriages for which the age is not stated are distributed in proportion before this calculation is made.

Marriages per 1,000 population

This is calculated for each year as follows:

Marriages per 1,000 population = Number of Marriages registered multiplied by 1,000 and divided by population.

Marriage data 1997-2004 The CSO are currently working with the GRO to identify a process for the extraction of marriage data from the marriage registration forms for the year 1997-2001. The introduction of the electronic registration of marriages for all marriages since September 2003 is also causing some difficulties in relation to the preparation of marriage data for 2003 and 2004. Data for all of these years will be made available as soon as possible.

NUTS2 and NUTS3 regions

The regional classifications in this release are based on the NUTS (Nomenclature of Territorial Units) classification used by Eurostat. The NUTS3 regions correspond to the eight Regional Authorities established under the Local Government Act, 1991 (Regional Authorities) (Establishment) Order, 1993, which came into operation on 1 January 1994. The NUTS2 regions, which were proposed by Government and agreed by Eurostat in 1999, are groupings of the NUTS3 regions. The composition of the regions is set out below.

Border, Midland and Western NUTS2 Region

Southern and Eastern NUTS2 Region
