**NOTE.**—The following alterations in the extent of the baronies of the county of Carlow have been made since 1831.—The townlands of Bennekerry in the parishes of Urgan and Ballinacarrig, and Busherstown in the parish of Killerrig, have been transferred from Rathvilly to Carlow; they contain 303 persons. The townland of Aghade in the parish of Aghade, has been transferred from Carlow to Forth; it contains 98 persons; and the townlands of Castlegrove in the parish of Aghade, Castlegrove and Drisoge in the parish of Ballon, and Newtown in the parish of Barragh, have been transferred from Rathvilly to Forth; they contain 184 persons. The townland of Ladystown in the parish of Balinglass, has been transferred from the barony of Upper Talbotstown, in the county of Wicklow, to Rathvilly barony; it contains 83 persons. The townland of Templeowen in the parish of Fennagh, has been transferred from Carlow to Rathvilly; it contains 457 persons.—*and 7 Wm. IV., c. 84, s. 51.*
