Maidenhill, part of Robertshill, and part of Marnells-meadows, in the parish of St. Canice, containing 74 persons—Archersgrove, Archersleas, Ardsraddaun, Baunreagh, Birchfield, Castleblunden, Clonmorán, Cox's-fields, Danville, Donaghmore, Drakeland lower, middle, and upper, Dicksborough, part of Dukemesadows, Gallowshill, Holdensrath, Joinersfolly, Kilcreen, Kylebeg, Loughboy, Margaret's fields, Mortgagefields, Palmerstown, Poulgour, Raggettsland, Reviewfields, Shellumsrath, Smithsland north and south, Springhill, Warrington, Wetland, in the parish of St. Patrick, containing 1,222 persons, and part of Dukemesadows, in the parish of St. John, uninhabited, have been transferred to the barony of Shillelogher—

Archersrath, Baun, Bonnetsrath, Brownstown, Blanchfieldsland, Bleachgreen, Cellarstown east, west, upper, and lower, Charterschool land, Dunmore, Dunmore park, part of Friarsinch, Garretcreen, part of Glandine, Greenridge, Kingsland, Kyleroe, Leggetsrath east and part of west, Loughmerans, part of Lacken, Lyrath, Maudlinland, Middleknock, Neworchard, Newtown, part of Pennefathers-lot, Purcellsinch, Quarryland, Radestown north and south, part of Roachpond, Seixeslough, Sion hermitage, and Templemartin in the parish of St. John, containing 1,655 persons; Newpark upper and part of Newpark lower, in the parish of St. Maul, containing 230 persons, have been transferred to the barony of Gowran.—
