The townlands of Breaghy and Lisduff, in the parish of Clonbroney, have been transferred from the barony of Ardagh to the barony of Granard; they contain 136 persons. The townland of Annagh and a portion of Lough Ree, in the parish

of Noughaval, have been transferred from the barony of Shrule to the barony of Rathcline; Annagh contains 26 persons. The townlands of Aghamore, Killinaker, and Knockmacrory, in the parish of Mohill, have been transferred from the barony and county of Longford to the barony of Mohill, county of Leitrim; they contain 137 persons.—6 § 7 Wm.
