NOTE.—That portion of the ancient county of the city of Waterford lying without the municipal boundary, constituting the parish of Kilbarry, and parts of the parishes of

Kilcullihean, St. John without, Kill St. Nicholas, and St. Stephen without, has been transferred to the barony of Gaultiere; it contains 3,673 persons. The remaining portion lying without the municipal boundary, constituting the parish of Killoteran, and part of the parish of Trinity without, has been transferred to the barony of Middlethird; it contains 2,683 persons.—3 and 4 Vict., c. 108 and 109.
